20 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:  
21

22 SECTION 1. REGULAR SALARIES. There is hereby established for the State  
23 Board of Pharmacy for the 2016-2017 fiscal year, the following maximum number  
24 of regular employees.

4 SECTION 2. EXTRA HELP. There is hereby authorized, for the State Board  
 5 of Pharmacy for the 2016-2017 fiscal year, the following maximum number of  
 6 part-time or temporary employees, to be known as "Extra Help", payable from  
 7 funds appropriated herein for such purposes: four (4) temporary or part-time  
 8 employees, when needed, at rates of pay not to exceed those provided in the  
 9 Uniform Classification and Compensation Act, or its successor, or this act  
 10 for the appropriate classification.  
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12 SECTION 3. APPROPRIATION - CASH OPERATIONS. There is hereby  
 13 appropriated, to the State Board of Pharmacy, to be payable from the cash  
 14 fund deposited in the State Treasury as determined by the Chief Fiscal  
 15 Officer of the State, for personal services and operating expenses of the  
 16 State Board of Pharmacy for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2017, the  
 17 following:

 34 SECTION 4. APPROPRIATION - PHARMACY STUDENT LOANS. There is hereby  
 35 appropriated, to the State Board of Pharmacy, to be payable from the cash  
 36 fund deposited in the State Treasury as determined by the Chief Fiscal

1 Officer of the State, for transfer by warrant to the cash fund as defined by  
 2 Arkansas Code 19-4-801 of the University of Arkansas for Medical Sciences -  
 3 College of Pharmacy for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2017, the following:

 9 SECTION 5. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS  
 10 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. TRANSFER  
 11 BY WARRANT. If, during the ~~2015-2016~~ 2016-2017 fiscal year, the need arises  
 12 for additional funding for student loans and additional funds become  
 13 available, the Director of the State Board of Pharmacy may request the Chief  
 14 Fiscal Officer of the State to cause a transfer by warrant up to fifty  
 15 thousand dollars (\$50,000) from the balance of cash funds deposited in the  
 16 State Treasury for the State Board of Pharmacy to the cash fund as defined by  
 17 the Arkansas Code 19-4-801 of the University of Arkansas for Medical  
 18 Sciences, there to be used for the sole purpose of providing student loans to  
 19 pharmacy students.

20 The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1, ~~2015~~  
 21 2016 through June 30, ~~2016~~ 2017.  
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23 SECTION 6. COMPLIANCE WITH OTHER LAWS. Disbursement of funds  
 24 authorized by this act shall be limited to the appropriation for such agency  
 25 and funds made available by law for the support of such appropriations; and  
 26 the restrictions of the State Procurement Law, the General Accounting and  
 27 Budgetary Procedures Law, the Revenue Stabilization Law, the Regular Salary  
 28 Procedures and Restrictions Act, or their successors, and other fiscal  
 29 control laws of this State, where applicable, and regulations promulgated by  
 30 the Department of Finance and Administration, as authorized by law, shall be  
 31 strictly complied with in disbursement of said funds.  
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33 SECTION 7. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General  
 34 Assembly that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations  
 35 contained in this act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for  
 36 which this act was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive

1 Recommendations and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget  
2 manuals prepared by the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or  
3 summarized oral testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative  
4 Council or Joint Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption.  
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6 SECTION 8. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the General  
7 Assembly, that the Constitution of the State of Arkansas prohibits the  
8 appropriation of funds for more than a one (1) year period; that the  
9 effectiveness of this Act on July 1, 2016 is essential to the operation of  
10 the agency for which the appropriations in this Act are provided, and that in  
11 the event of an extension of the legislative session, the delay in the  
12 effective date of this Act beyond July 1, 2016 could work irreparable harm  
13 upon the proper administration and provision of essential governmental  
14 programs. Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act  
15 being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health  
16 and safety shall be in full force and effect from and after July 1, 2016.  
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
