Unallocated funds will be redistributed based upon need as 16 determined by the Career Education and Workforce Development Board. 17 The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1, 2015 18 2016 through June 30, <del>2016</del> 2017.

20 SECTION 28. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS 21 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. TRANSFER 22 OF FUNDS - PROMOTIONAL ITEMS. The Chief Fiscal Officer of the State shall 23 establish, upon request from the Department of Career Education, a special 24 appropriation line item to be used in the acquisition of promotional items. 25 When the Department of Career Education wishes to transfer monies from its 26 operating expenses appropriation to the Promotional Items line, the Career 27 Education and Workforce Development Board shall approve the request and 28 forward it after receiving prior review and approval by the Arkansas 29 Legislative Council or Joint Budget Committee, to the Chief Fiscal Officer of 30 the State for processing.

Determining the maximum number of employees and the maximum amount of appropriation and general revenue funding for a state agency each fiscal year is the prerogative of the General Assembly. This is usually accomplished by delineating such maximums in the appropriation act(s) for a state agency and the general revenue allocations authorized for each fund and fund account by amendment to the Revenue Stabilization law. Further, the General Assembly

1 has determined that the Department of Career Education may operate more 2 efficiently if some flexibility is provided to the Department of Career 3 Education authorizing broad powers under this Section. Therefore, it is both 4 necessary and appropriate that the General Assembly maintain oversight by 5 requiring prior approval of the Legislative Council or Joint Budget Committee 6 as provided by this section. The requirement of approval by the Legislative 7 Council or Joint Budget Committee is not a severable part of this section. 8 If the requirement of approval by the Legislative Council or Joint Budget 9 Committee is ruled unconstitutional by a court of competent jurisdiction, 10 this entire section is void.

11 The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1, 2015 12 2016 through June 30, <del>2016</del> 2017.

14 SECTION 29. COMPLIANCE WITH OTHER LAWS. Disbursement of funds 15 authorized by this act shall be limited to the appropriation for such agency 16 and funds made available by law for the support of such appropriations; and 17 the restrictions of the State Procurement Law, the General Accounting and 18 Budgetary Procedures Law, the Revenue Stabilization Law, the Regular Salary 19 Procedures and Restrictions Act, or their successors, and other fiscal 20 control laws of this State, where applicable, and regulations promulgated by 21 the Department of Finance and Administration, as authorized by law, shall be 22 strictly complied with in disbursement of said funds.

23

24 SECTION 30. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General 25 Assembly that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations 26 contained in this act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for 27 which this act was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive 28 Recommendations and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget 29 manuals prepared by the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or 30 summarized oral testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative 31 Council or Joint Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption. 32

33 SECTION 31. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the General Assembly, that the Constitution of the State of Arkansas prohibits

35 the appropriation of funds for more than a one (1) year period; that the

effectiveness of this Act on July 1, 2016 is essential to the operation of 36

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1	the agency for which the appropriations in this Act are provided, and that in	
2	the event of an extension of the legislative session, the delay in the	
3	effective date of this Act beyond July 1, 2016 could work irreparable harm	
4	upon the proper administration and provision of essential governmental	
5	programs. Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act	
6	being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health	
7	and safety shall be in full force and effect from and after July 1, 2016.	
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
