AN ACT TO MAKE AN APPROPRIATION FOR PERSONAL SERVICES  
AND OPERATING EXPENSES FOR THE NORTHWEST TECHNICAL  
INSTITUTE FOR THE FISCAL YEAR ENDING JUNE 30, 2017;  
AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

## Subtitle

AN ACT FOR THE NORTHWEST TECHNICAL  
INSTITUTE APPROPRIATION FOR THE 2016-2017  
FISCAL YEAR.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

SECTION 1. REGULAR SALARIES. There is hereby established for the  
Northwest Technical Institute for the 2016-2017 fiscal year, the following  
maximum number of regular employees.

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19       SECTION 2. EXTRA HELP. There is hereby authorized, for the Northwest  
20 Technical Institute for the 2016-2017 fiscal year, the following maximum  
21 number of part-time or temporary employees, to be known as "Extra Help",  
22 payable from funds appropriated herein for such purposes: one hundred seven  
23 (107) temporary or part-time employees, when needed, at rates of pay not to  
24 exceed those provided in the Uniform Classification and Compensation Act, or  
25 its successor, or this act for the appropriate classification.

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27       SECTION 3. APPROPRIATION - STATE. There is hereby appropriated, to the  
28 Northwest Technical Institute, to be payable from the Northwest Technical  
29 Institute Fund, for personal services and operating expenses of the Northwest  
30 Technical Institute for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2017, the following:

There is hereby appropriated, to the Northwest Technical Institute, to be payable from cash funds as defined by Arkansas Code 19-4-801 of the Northwest Technical Institute, for personal services and operating expenses of the Northwest Technical Institute for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2017, the following:

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12 SECTION 6. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS  
 13 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW.  
 14 ADDITIONAL TEACHING LOAD. Instructional staff at Northwest Technical  
 15 Institute, may be paid up to fifty dollars (\$50) per clock hour for the  
 16 fiscal year ending June 30, ~~2016~~ 2017, for noncredit teaching assignments; or  
 17 up to five hundred fifty dollars (\$550) per semester hour for the fiscal year  
 18 ending June 30, ~~2016~~ 2017, for teaching courses beyond the defined teaching  
 19 load; and the employee's maximum allowable salary may be exceeded by such  
 20 amount; provided, however, that such additional teaching load may not exceed  
 21 one hundred fifty (150) clock hours or nine (9) semester credit hours per  
 22 school year. Further, the provisions of this section shall only apply to  
 23 credit and noncredit courses that are funded by Private Industry.

24 The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1, ~~2015~~  
 25 2016 through June 30, ~~2016~~ 2017.

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27 SECTION 7. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS  
 28 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. EXTRA  
 29 HELP RESTRICTION. No employee at Northwest Technical Institute, who is  
 30 employed as "Extra Help" may exceed eighty-five percent (85%) of the maximum  
 31 annual salary for a comparable position as authorized under Arkansas Code 21-  
 32 5-201 et seq. during any fiscal year, nor shall such employee be employed for  
 33 a period of time to exceed fourteen hundred (1400) hours in any single fiscal  
 34 year.

35 The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1, ~~2015~~  
 36 2016 through June 30, ~~2016~~ 2017.

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2 SECTION 8. COMPLIANCE WITH OTHER LAWS. Disbursement of funds  
3 authorized by this act shall be limited to the appropriation for such agency  
4 and funds made available by law for the support of such appropriations; and  
5 the restrictions of the State Procurement Law, the General Accounting and  
6 Budgetary Procedures Law, the Revenue Stabilization Law, the Regular Salary  
7 Procedures and Restrictions Act, or their successors, and other fiscal  
8 control laws of this State, where applicable, and regulations promulgated by  
9 the Department of Finance and Administration, as authorized by law, shall be  
10 strictly complied with in disbursement of said funds.  
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12 SECTION 9. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General  
13 Assembly that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations  
14 contained in this act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for  
15 which this act was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive  
16 Recommendations and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget  
17 manuals prepared by the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or  
18 summarized oral testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative  
19 Council or Joint Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption.  
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21 SECTION 10. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the  
22 General Assembly, that the Constitution of the State of Arkansas prohibits  
23 the appropriation of funds for more than a one (1) year period; that the  
24 effectiveness of this Act on July 1, 2016 is essential to the operation of  
25 the agency for which the appropriations in this Act are provided, and that in  
26 the event of an extension of the legislative session, the delay in the  
27 effective date of this Act beyond July 1, 2016 could work irreparable harm  
28 upon the proper administration and provision of essential governmental  
29 programs. Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act  
30 being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health  
31 and safety shall be in full force and effect from and after July 1, 2016.  
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
