11 STATE FOR THE FISCAL YEAR ENDING JUNE 30, 2017; AND
12 FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

16 STATE APPROPRIATION FOR THE 2016-2017
17 FISCAL YEAR.
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21 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:
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23 SECTION 1. REGULAR SALARIES - OPERATIONS. There is hereby established
24 for the Office of the Treasurer of State for the 2016-2017 fiscal year, the
25 following maximum number of regular employees.

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11 SECTION 2. EXTRA HELP - OPERATIONS. There is hereby authorized, for
 12 the Office of the Treasurer of State for the 2016-2017 fiscal year, the
 13 following maximum number of part-time or temporary employees, to be known as
 14 "Extra Help", payable from funds appropriated herein for such purposes: ten
 15 (10) temporary or part-time employees, when needed, at rates of pay not to
 16 exceed those provided in the Uniform Classification and Compensation Act, or
 17 its successor, or this act for the appropriate classification.

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19 SECTION 3. APPROPRIATION - OPERATIONS. There is hereby appropriated,
 20 to the Office of the Treasurer of State, to be payable from the State Central
 21 Services Fund, for personal services, operating expenses, data processing
 22 system/services and debt collection of the Office of the Treasurer of State
 23 for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2017, the following:

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 3 SECTION 4. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS
 4 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. TRANSFER
 5 PROVISION. After receiving approval from the Chief Fiscal Officer of the
 6 State, and prior review by the Arkansas Legislative Council, the Treasurer of
 7 State is authorized to transfer appropriation from any line item authorized
 8 in Section 3 Appropriation - Operations of the Treasurer's Office in this Act
 9 to any other line item authorized in Section 3.

10 The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1, ~~2015~~
 11 2016 through June 30, ~~2016~~ 2017.

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 13 SECTION 5. COMPLIANCE WITH OTHER LAWS. Disbursement of funds
 14 authorized by this act shall be limited to the appropriation for such agency
 15 and funds made available by law for the support of such appropriations; and
 16 the restrictions of the State Procurement Law, the General Accounting and
 17 Budgetary Procedures Law, the Revenue Stabilization Law, the Regular Salary
 18 Procedures and Restrictions Act, or their successors, and other fiscal
 19 control laws of this State, where applicable, and regulations promulgated by
 20 the Department of Finance and Administration, as authorized by law, shall be
 21 strictly complied with in disbursement of said funds.

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 23 SECTION 6. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General
 24 Assembly that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations
 25 contained in this act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for
 26 which this act was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive
 27 Recommendations and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget
 28 manuals prepared by the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or
 29 summarized oral testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative
 30 Council or Joint Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption.

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 32 SECTION 7. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the General
 33 Assembly, that the Constitution of the State of Arkansas prohibits the
 34 appropriation of funds for more than a one (1) year period; that the
 35 effectiveness of this Act on July 1, 2016 is essential to the operation of
 36 the agency for which the appropriations in this Act are provided, and that in

the event of an extension of the legislative session, the delay in the effective date of this Act beyond July 1, 2016 could work irreparable harm upon the proper administration and provision of essential governmental programs. Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety shall be in full force and effect from and after July 1, 2016.

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
