14 SECTION 19. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS 15 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. COMMUNITY 16 CORRECTION PROGRAM LINE ITEM USES. The appropriations authorized under the 17 line item established herein for "Community Correction Program" are to be 18 used by the Department of Community Correction for establishment and 19 operation of, to include construction, renovation, and contracting for 20 establishment and operation of, residential and non-residential community 21 correction programs such as, but not limited to, community correction 22 centers, drug, alcohol, and mental health treatments, intensive supervision, 23 restitution, and others as established and approved by the Board of 24 Corrections and as may be provided by law.

The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1, 2015

28 SECTION 20. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS 29 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. TRANSFER 30 AUTHORITY FOR UTILITY AND FUEL RATE INCREASE. In the event of a ten percent (10%) increase in utility and fuel rates, the Department of Community 31 32 Correction is authorized to transfer from any line item in Section 3 - State 33 Operations to Operating Expense Item (05)(A) in Section 3 - State Operations 34 for support of the increase after receiving approval of the Chief Fiscal 35 Officer of the State. Prior to the utilization of the transfer authority a 36 report shall be made to the Arkansas Legislative Council or Joint Budget

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 $1 \$ Committee including justification for the transfer and the amount of

2 transfer.

3 Determining the maximum number of employees and the maximum amount of 4 appropriation and general revenue funding for a state agency each fiscal year 5 is the prerogative of the General Assembly. This is usually accomplished by 6 delineating such maximums in the appropriation act(s) for a state agency and 7 the general revenue allocations authorized for each fund and fund account by 8 amendment to the Revenue Stabilization law. Further, the General Assembly 9 has determined that the Department of Community Correction may operate more 10 efficiently if some flexibility is provided to the Department of Community 11 Correction authorizing broad powers under this Section. It is the intent of the General 12 Assembly that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations contained in this act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for 13 14 which this act was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive 15 Recommendations and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget 16 manuals prepared by the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or 17 summarized oral testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative 18 Council or Joint Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption. 19

20 SECTION 24. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the General Assembly, that the Constitution of the State of Arkansas prohibits 21 22 the appropriation of funds for more than a one (1) year period; that the 23 effectiveness of this Act on July 1, 2016 is essential to the operation of the agency for which the appropriations in this Act are provided, and that in 24 25 the event of an extension of the legislative session, the delay in the 26 effective date of this Act beyond July 1, 2016 could work irreparable harm 27 upon the proper administration and provision of essential governmental programs.
