21 SECTION 15. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS 22 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. TRANSFER 23 PROVISION. The Department of Arkansas State Police is hereby authorized, 24 after seeking the approval of the Chief Fiscal Officer of the State, to 25 request transfer from the appropriation made herein for "Confiscated Funds 26 Transfer" to the Overtime, Personal Services Matching, and Maintenance and 27 General Operations classifications established in the operations 28 appropriation of the Department of Arkansas State Police, and may be used for 29 overtime, personal services matching, motor vehicle purchases and associated 30 taxes and/or motor vehicle equipping/renovation costs, agency operational 31 needs and capital improvements for the Department of Arkansas State Police. 32 Fund transfers may be requested from the Court Awards Fund to the Department 33 of Arkansas State Police Fund in the same amount and for the same purposes as 34 the appropriation transfer requested under the provisions of this section. 35 The provisions of this section shall be subject to prior review and approval 36 of the Arkansas Legislative Council or Joint Budget Committee.

30 SECTION 17. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS 31 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. OVERTIME. 32 The Department of Arkansas State Police is hereby authorized to make overtime 33 payments from such funds and appropriations provided for overtime payments to 34 those officers or other employees that are currently assigned or may be 35 assigned by the Director of the Department of Arkansas State Police to 36 Special Law Enforcement Task Forces and other special programs reimbursable

to Arkansas State Police by federal or local authorities as approved by the Director of the Department of Arkansas State Police. All such overtime payments shall be processed through the State Accounting System and shall be in addition to the Regular Salaries and benefits accruing to the employee. Payment of overtime is the preferred method of implementing the provisions of this section.

The Department of Arkansas State Police is hereby 13 authorized to purchase motor vehicles from the appropriations authorized for 14 Capital Outlay in the State Police Operations appropriation in this Act. 15 Motor vehicles donated to Arkansas State Police and confiscated vehicles used 16 for Arkansas State Police operations shall not be included in the maximum 17 number of authorized passenger vehicles.

SECTION 19. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS 21 22 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. UNIFORM 23 EMPLOYEE HEALTH INSURANCE PROGRAM REPORTING. The Department of Arkansas 24 State Police shall report monthly to the Governor, the Chief Fiscal Officer 25 of the State and to the Arkansas Legislative Council or Joint Budget 26 Committee regarding the activity and condition for the uniformed employee 27 health insurance plan. The report shall include, but not limited to, the 28 beginning reserve fund balance, contributions made during the month, claims 29 paid, and the ending fund balance of the month. In the event it is determined 30 that the cost to adequately maintain the uniform employee health insurance 31 plan is not feasible within the existing resources available to the department, the 90th General Assembly shall study the feasibility and 32 33 desirability of discontinuing the self-insurance program and instead provide 34 medical and hospital insurance to uniform employees through the public 35 employees insurance program.

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3 SECTION 20. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. The Department of Arkansas State Police is hereby 6 authorized to purchase from Maintenance & Operations Classifications in the 7 Operations Appropriation provided by in this Act, up to an amount not to 8 exceed two thousand five hundred dollars (\$2,500) each fiscal year, for emergency purchases for food, drinks and other essential items during 9 10 emergency operations only when authorized by the Agency Director. During an 11 emergency, an ASP employee may be designated and authorized, by the Director, 12 to incur expenses for all deployed personnel. 13 The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1, 2015

SECTION 21. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS 16 17 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. ARKANSAS 18 WIRELESS INFORMATION NETWORK. Once the requirements of Arkansas Code §12-8-19 310 are satisfied, the second two million dollars (\$2,000,000) deposited into 20 the Department of Arkansas State Police Fund generated by Arkansas Code §27-21 16-801(a) shall be used for the operations, maintenance, equipment and 22 various system requirements and expenses of the Department of Arkansas State 23 Police - Arkansas Wireless Information Network.

24 The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1, 2015 25 2016 through June 30, 2016 2017.

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27 SECTION 22. COMPLIANCE WITH OTHER LAWS. Disbursement of funds 28 authorized by this act shall be limited to the appropriation for such agency 29 and funds made available by law for the support of such appropriations; and 30 the restrictions of the State Procurement Law, the General Accounting and 31 Budgetary Procedures Law, the Revenue Stabilization Law, the Regular Salary 32 Procedures and Restrictions Act, or their successors, and other fiscal 33 control laws of this State, where applicable, and regulations promulgated by 34 the Department of Finance and Administration, as authorized by law, shall be 35 strictly complied with in disbursement of said funds.

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1 SECTION 23. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General 2 Assembly that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations contained in this act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for 3 4 which this act was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive 5 Recommendations and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget 6 manuals prepared by the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or 7 summarized oral testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative 8 Council or Joint Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption. 9 10 SECTION 24. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the

11 General Assembly, that the Constitution of the State of Arkansas prohibits

12 the appropriation of funds for more than a one (1) year period; that the 13 effectiveness of this Act on July 1, 2016 is essential to the operation of 14 the agency for which the appropriations in this Act are provided, and that in

15 the event of an extension of the legislative session, the delay in the

16 effective date of this Act beyond July 1, 2016 could work irreparable harm

17 upon the proper administration and provision of essential governmental

18 programs. Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act

19 being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health

20 and safety shall be in full force and effect from and after July 1, 2016.

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
