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1 SECTION 7. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS 2 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. AGING AND 3 ADULT SERVICES - MATCHING FUNDS. The funds appropriated for state match for 4 the Arkansas Senior Olympics Program in this Act shall be paid on a two-to-5 one state/local matching basis. 16	programs. Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act
17	being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health
18	and safety shall be in full force and effect from and after July 1, 2016.
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
