The funds so transferred 8 shall be subject to accounting in a manner substantially similar to that 9 employed by the Arkansas State Police for such transactions; provided 10 however, that information tending to identify participants in such 11 transactions shall be exempt from the Arkansas Freedom of Information Act. 12 The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1, 2015 13 2016 through June 30, <del>2016</del> 2017.

SECTION 16. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS
CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. HUMAN
SERVICES RENOVATION FUND. Department of Human Services Renovation Fund.
(a) There is established on the books of the Treasurer of State, Auditor
of State, and the Chief Fiscal Officer of the State a fund to be known as the
Department of Human Services Renovation Fund.

(b) This fund shall be used for constructing, acquiring, renovating,
maintaining, repairing, and equipping facilities of the Department of Human
Services and for paying disallowances by the federal government.

24 (c) The fund shall consist of:

25 (1) Federal reimbursement received by the Department of Human Services and 26 deposited in the various fund accounts of the department; and 27 (2) General revenues transferred from the Division of Youth Services, the Division of Behavioral Health, and the Division of Developmental Disabilities 28 29 Services for the purposes of repairing, renovating, equipping, acquiring and constructing Department of Human Services facilities with an annual maximum 30 31 of five million dollars (\$5,000,000). The projects for which these transfers 32 are authorized must be projects which were unanticipated during the preceding 33 regular session of the Arkansas General Assembly and must be projects which, 34 if not carried out in the interim period between regular sessions of the 35 Arkansas General Assembly would cause greater harm to the facilities, clients 36 or programs of the Department of Human Services than to wait until the next

l regular session.

2 (3) Other non-general revenue funds as may be available within the Department3 of Human Services that can be used for the purposes of this fund.

4 (d)(1) At the request of the Director of the Department of Human Services,
5 and upon certification of the availability of such funds, the Chief Fiscal
6 Officer of the State shall initiate the necessary transfer documents to
7 reflect the transfer on the books of record of the Treasurer of State, the
8 Auditor of State, the Chief Fiscal Officer of the State, and the Department
9 of Human Services.

(2) The Director of the Department of Human Services shall submit any
transfer plan to and must receive approval of the plan from the Chief Fiscal
Officer of the State, the Governor and the Arkansas Legislative Council prior
to the effective date of the transfer.

(e) Provided, that any non-general revenue funding that may remain in the fund at the end of any fiscal year shall be carried over into the next fiscal year and all obligated general revenue funding that may remain in the fund at the end of any fiscal year shall be carried over into the next fiscal year to satisfy such legal and contractual obligations that have been entered into prior to the end of the fiscal year.

20 (f) Determining the amount of funds appropriated to a state agency is the 21 prerogative of the General Assembly and is usually accomplished by 22 delineating specific line items and by identifying the appropriation and 23 funding attached to that line item. The General Assembly has determined that 24 the Department of Human Services could be operated more efficiently if some 25 flexibility is given to that agency. That flexibility is being accomplished by providing transfer authority in subsection (d) of this section, and since 26 27 the General Assembly has granted the agency broad powers under the transfer 28 authority concept, it is both necessary and appropriate that the General 29 Assembly maintain oversight of the utilization of the transfer authority by requiring prior approval of the Legislative Council in the utilization of 30 31 this transfer authority. Therefore, the requirement of approval by the Legislative Council is not a severable part of this section. If the 32 33 requirement of approval by the Legislative Council is ruled unconstitutional 34 by a court of competent jurisdiction, this entire section is void. The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1, 2015 35 36 2016 through June 30, 2016 2017.

2 SECTION 17. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS 3 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. TRANSFER 4 AUTHORITY. The Director of the Department of Human Services shall have 5 transfer authority provided by the following:

6 (a) DEPARTMENT OF HUMAN SERVICES RENOVATION FUND. The Director of the Department of Human Services is authorized to request fund transfers 7 8 according to the provisions established by Arkansas Code Ann. 19-5-1020, 9 Department of Human Services Renovation Fund, as amended herein; and 10 (b) MATCH TRANSFER. The Director of the Department of Human Services, 11 with the approval of the Chief Fiscal Officer of the State, is authorized to 12 effect inter-agency and inter-divisional fund transfers for the purpose of 13 providing the State's matching share for payments made to that Division or 14 Office or its service providers for services eligible for federal

15 reimbursement under programs administered by the Department of Human 16 Services. The Department of Human Services shall report to the Legislative 17 Council or Joint Budget Committee on a quarterly basis all fund transfers 18 made in accordance with the authority granted by this section; and

19 (c) YOUTH SERVICES - HOUSING AND SEPARATION APPROPRIATION PROVISIONS. The 20 Division of Youth Services (DYS) is authorized to fulfill its responsibility 21 to house offenders between the ages of 18 and 21 and to separate juvenile 22 offenders by age and seriousness of offense by either employing additional 23 state employees and providing the corresponding operating expenses or 24 entering into professional services contracts. If the Division of Youth 25 Services determines that the Division needs to employ state employees to 26 fulfill the housing and separation requirements, they may transfer up to the 27 total amount appropriated for the DYS - Residential Services Program 28 appropriation to the appropriate DYS appropriation and line items, upon 29 approval of the Chief Fiscal Officer of the State, and prior review by the 30 Legislative Council; and

(d) REALLOCATION OF RESOURCES: (1) The Department of Human Services (DHS) provides hundreds of different services to over 1 million Arkansans. The specific mix of service needs and the funding and staffing required to provide them can vary significantly based on many factors, including natural disasters, changing federal mandates and funding sources, demographic shifts, fluctuating court-ordered services, social trends, and job market variations

1 such as nursing shortages. The impact of these factors through the course of 2 any fiscal year make it very difficult for the Department to accurately predict the exact needs for funding, appropriation and positions in each of 3 4 its over 100 different appropriations. To ensure that it can respond quickly 5 to changing client needs and make the most effective use of the resources 6 allocated to it, the Department of Human Services shall be authorized to 7 utilize the reallocation of resource authority to make the proper adjustments 8 to the budgets within the Department. Therefore, upon determination by the 9 Director of the Department of Human Services that a reallocation of resources within the department is necessary for the efficient and effective operation 10 11 of the department, the director, with approval of the Governor, shall have 12 the authority to request, from the Chief Fiscal Officer of the State, a 13 transfer of positions, appropriations, line item appropriations, and funds 14 within or between existing and newly created divisions, offices, sections, or 15 units of the department. Provided, however, that no transfer of funds or 16 appropriation that provides direct support or matching support for the 17 Arkansas Medicaid Program shall be made to any other fund account or 18 appropriation that does not directly support the Arkansas Medicaid Program. 19 Further, no positions, funds, or appropriation authorized during the budget 20 process for the Division of Children and Family Services compliance with 21 initiatives established under the Angela R. consent decree shall be 22 transferred to any other division. Nothing in this provision is intended to 23 prevent the one-time transfers of savings in any other program to the 24 Arkansas Medicaid Program, with the exception of the provisions previously 25 cited for the Division of Children and Family Services - Angela R. consent 26 decree. The Division of Developmental Disabilities - Grants to Community 27 Providers line item of the Developmental Disabilities Services - Grants-in-28 Aid appropriation may not be decreased. The appropriation, funding, and 29 positions provided for the five Human Development Centers shall remain at a 30 level sufficient to ensure quality care for the Centers' residents. The 31 exemptions provided in this subsection whereby certain DHS Programs and 32 Divisions are protected from appropriation, fund, or position transfers are 33 applicable only to the reallocation or transfer authority granted herein, and 34 not by any reductions which are applicable to all state programs. 35 The Director of the Department of Human Services shall submit any requests

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for transfers to and must receive approval of the requests for transfers from

1 the Chief Fiscal Officer of the State, the Governor, and the Arkansas 2 Legislative Council prior to the effective date of the transfers. Provided, however, that the Department of Human Services shall be limited to submitting 3 4 no more than two reallocation of resources transfer requests during any 5 fiscal year. In each Departmental request no single division will request 6 reallocation for more than one purpose as listed in this section. Transfer 7 authority for unforeseen purposes shall further be limited to no more than 5% 8 of the total appropriation, funding, and positions authorized for the 9 Department. Reallocation of resources transfers may include multiple items 10 but shall be limited to the following purposes: 11 i). Medicaid Program 12 ii). Facilities and institutions costs, including operational expenses and 13 construction/renovation/equipping expenses 14 iii). Departmental grants and contracts 15 iv). Court ordered settlements and payments 16 v). Payment of administrative expenses, including but not limited to, 17 overtime and other costs of personnel for critical services or functions 18 necessary to carry out the mission of the agency 19 vi). Restructuring efforts as deemed necessary to comply with new and/or 20 unanticipated federal or state mandates 21 vii). Redirecting internal resources, both direct and/or indirect, to meet 22 client needs and services 23 Determining the maximum number of employees and the maximum amount of 24 appropriation and general revenue funding for a state agency each fiscal year 25 is the prerogative of the General Assembly. This is usually accomplished by 26 delineating such maximums in the appropriation act(s) for a state agency and 27 the general revenue allocations authorized for each fund and fund account by 28 amendment to the Revenue Stabilization law. Further, the General Assembly has 29 determined that the Department of Human Services may operate more efficiently 30 if some flexibility is provided to the Department of Human Services 31 authorizing broad powers under the Reallocation of Resources provisions 32 herein. Therefore, it is both necessary and appropriate that the General 33 Assembly maintain oversight by requiring prior approval of the Legislative 34 Council or Joint Budget Committee as provided by this section. The 35 requirement of approval by the Legislative Council or Joint Budget Committee 36 is not a severable part of this section. If the requirement of approval by

1 the Legislative Council or Joint Budget Committee is ruled unconstitutional 2 by a court of competent jurisdiction, this entire section is void. (2) If it is determined that the requested reallocation of resources 3 4 transfers should be made, the Chief Fiscal Officer of the State shall then 5 initiate the necessary transfer documents to reflect the transfers upon the 6 fiscal records of the Treasurer of State, the Auditor of State, the Chief 7 Fiscal Officer of the State, and the Department of Human Services. In 8 addition, the Chief Fiscal Officer of the State, together with the Co-9 Chairpersons of the Legislative Council or Joint Budget Committee, may 10 approve, on an emergency basis, requests for utilization of this Section 11 without prior approval of the Arkansas Legislative Council, with any such 12 actions reported at the next meeting of the Arkansas Legislative Council. The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1, 2015 13 14 2016 through June 30, 2016 2017.

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16 SECTION 18. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS 17 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. 18 NURSING/DIRECT CARE EDUCATION STIPEND PROGRAM. Special provision for a 19 Nursing/Direct Care Education Stipend Program for the Department of Human 20 Services is hereby authorized to pay from State and Federal Funds 21 appropriated in each division Act. This program is for eligible nursing 22 students who are attending accredited nursing institutions to become 23 Registered or Licensed Practical Nurses, as well as Certified Nursing 24 Assistants, Residential Care Assistants, Residential Care Technicians, 25 Residential Care Supervisors and Behavioral Health Aides.

26 The stipend is \$5,000 per person per year. Any student who is awarded and 27 accepts a stipend is under employment commitment to the respective DHS 28 Division and is required to work for that division, in a full-time employee 29 status effective immediately upon graduation. The student employment 30 commitment is equal to the number of years the stipend was awarded and 31 accepted. In the event of Employee/Student default of the employment 32 commitment, the Employee/Student will be considered in breach of contract and 33 repayment of the stipend will be required as specified in the Stipend 34 Contract.

Each division participating in the Education Stipend Program shalldetermine on an annual basis, the number of student stipends available.

The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1, 2015
 2016 through June 30, 2016 2017.

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4 SECTION 19. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS 5 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. 6 NURSING/DIRECT CARE RECRUITMENT/RETENTION BONUSES. Special provision to 7 provide Nursing/Direct Care Recruitment and Retention Bonuses for the 8 Department of Human Services is hereby authorized to pay from State and 9 Federal funds appropriated for each respective division. Nursing/direct care 10 service recruitment/retention bonuses are in addition to the maximum annual 11 amounts provided in the Regular Salaries Section of the respective Division 12 Act for Registered Nurse, Licensed Practical Nurse, Certified Nursing 13 Assistant, Residential Care Assistant, Residential Care Technician, 14 Residential Care Supervisor and Behavioral Health Aide. New hire nurses must 15 be licensed by the Arkansas State Board of Nursing. The total 16 recruitment/retention bonus payment commitment for eligible nurses shall not 17 exceed \$4,000 per Registered Nurse and \$2,000 per Licensed Practical Nurse 18 and \$1,000 per Certified Nursing Assistant, Residential Care Assistant, 19 Residential Care Technician, Residential Care Supervisor and Behavioral 20 Health Aide. 21 The lump sum bonus payments and employment commitment to the State will be 22 made in partial payments as follows: 23 24 Registered Nurse Classifications 25 \$1,000 after completing 6 months probationary employment 26 \$1,500 after completing 1st year employment 27 \$1,500 after completing 2nd year employment 28 29 Licensed Practical Nurse Classifications \$ 500 after completing 6 months probationary employment 30 31 \$ 500 after completing 1st year employment 32 \$1,000 after completing 2nd year employment 33 Certified Nursing Assistant/Residential Care Assistant/Residential Care 34 35 Technician/Residential Care Supervisor/Behavioral Health Aide 36 Classifications

1 \$ 500 after completing 6 month probationary employment 2 \$ 500 after completing 1st year employment 3 4 Any qualified person hired and offered bonus payment described herein will 5 forfeit the balance of the payments if he/she voluntarily resigns or is 6 terminated for cause from employment from the Department of Human Services 7 prior to completing the required employment commitment time periods outlined 8 above. 9 The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1, 2015 10 2016 through June 30, <del>2016</del> 2017. 11 SECTION 20. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS 12 13 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. FUND 14 TRANSFER PROVISION - HEALTH CARE INDEPENDENCE PROGRAM TRUST FUND. 15 Notwithstanding any other provisions of law to the contrary, the entire 16 amount received and retained in the Medicaid Trust Fund from the Pulaski 17 County Circuit Court Case No. CV2007-15345 shall be transferred from the 18 Medicaid Trust Fund to the Health Care Independence Program Trust Fund to be 19 used exclusively as authorized by Ark. Code 19-5-1141. 20 The provisions of this section shall be in effect from July 1, 2015 21 2016 through June 30, <del>2016</del> 2017. 22 23 SECTION 21. COMPLIANCE WITH OTHER LAWS. Disbursement of funds authorized by this act shall be limited to the appropriation for such agency 24 25 and funds made available by law for the support of such appropriations; and 26 the restrictions of the State Procurement Law, the General Accounting and 27 Budgetary Procedures Law, the Revenue Stabilization Law, the Regular Salary 28 Procedures and Restrictions Act, or their successors, and other fiscal 29 control laws of this State, where applicable, and regulations promulgated by 30 the Department of Finance and Administration, as authorized by law, shall be 31 strictly complied with in disbursement of said funds. 32 33 SECTION 22. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General Assembly that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations 34 35 contained in this act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for 36 which this act was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive

10	the agency for which the appropriations in this Act are provided, and that in
