1 SECTION 2. APPROPRIATION - DIRECTOR'S OFFICE - OFFICE OF CHIEF COUNSEL 2 - OPERATIONS. There is hereby appropriated, to the Department of Human 3 Services - Director's Office, to be payable from the paying account as 4 determined by the Chief Fiscal Officer of the State, for personal services of 5 the Department of Human Services - Director's Office - Office of Chief 6 Counsel which shall be supplemental and in addition to those funds 7 appropriated in Section 6 of Act 928 of 2015, the following: 8 9 ITEM FISCAL YEAR 10 2015-2016 NO. 11 (01) REGULAR SALARIES \$118,962 12 (02) PERSONAL SERV MATCHING 27,314 TOTAL AMOUNT APPROPRIATED 13 \$146,276 14 15 SECTION 3. COMPLIANCE WITH OTHER LAWS. Disbursement of funds 16 authorized by this act shall be limited to the appropriation for such agency 17 and funds made available by law for the support of such appropriations; and 18 the restrictions of the State Procurement Law, the General Accounting and 19 Budgetary Procedures Law, the Revenue Stabilization Law, the Regular Salary 20 Procedures and Restrictions Act, or their successors, and other fiscal 21 control laws of this State, where applicable, and regulations promulgated by 22 the Department of Finance and Administration, as authorized by law, shall be 23 strictly complied with in disbursement of said funds. 24 SECTION 4. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General 25 26 Assembly that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations 27 contained in this act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for 28 which this act was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive 29 Recommendations and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget 30 manuals prepared by the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or 31 summarized oral testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative 32 Council or Joint Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption. 33 34 SECTION 5. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the General 35 Assembly, that funds provided by the General Assembly for the operations of 36 the Department of Human Services are, due to unforeseen circumstances,

1	<u>insufficient for the Department of Human Services to continue to provide</u>		
2	essential governmental services; that the provisions of this act will provide		
3	the necessary monies for the Department of Human Services to continue such		
4	services; and that a delay in the effective date of this Act could work		
5	irreparable harm upon the proper administration and provision of essential		
6	governmental programs. Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist		
7	and this Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public		
8	peace, health and safety shall be in full force and effect from and after the		
9	date of its passage and approval.		
10	If the bill is neither approved nor vetoed by the Governor, it shall		
11	become effective on the expiration of the period of time during which the		
12	Governor may veto the bill. If the bill is vetoed by the Governor and the		
13	veto is overridden, it shall become effective on the date the last house		
14	overrides the veto.		
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
