BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

SECTION 1. REGULAR SALARIES - HOUSE STAFF. There is hereby established

SECTION 11. APPROPRIATION - REAPPROPRIATION - CONSTITUTIONAL OFFICERS FUND. There is hereby appropriated, to the Arkansas House of Representatives, to be payable from the Constitutional Officers Fund, for the balance remaining on June 30, 2016 in the appropriations enacted to defray any necessary expenses of the House of Representatives of the Ninetieth General Assembly, Section 2 of Act 3 of 2015, Sections 4 and 11 of Act 82 of 2015,

1 and HB1001 as introduced in the 2016 Fiscal Session, there to be used for the
 2 same purposes for the Arkansas House of Representatives of the Ninetieth
 3 General Assembly, the sum in the aggregate not to exceed....\$3,079,226.
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5 SECTION 12. APPROPRIATION - REAPPROPRIATION - STATE CENTRAL SERVICES
 6 FUND. There is hereby appropriated, to the Arkansas House of Representatives,
 7 to be payable from the State Central Services Fund, for the balance remaining
 8 on June 30, 2016 in the appropriations enacted to defray any necessary
 9 expenses of the House of Representatives of the Ninetieth General Assembly,
 10 Sections 3, 5, 7, 9, 10 and 12 of Act 82 of 2015, there to be used for the
 11 same purposes for the Arkansas House of Representatives of the Ninetieth
 12 General Assembly, the sum in the aggregate not to exceed....\$3,000,000.
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14 SECTION 13. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS
 15 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. USES OF
 16 FUNDS. The funds appropriated in this Act shall be used to defray the
 17 necessary expenses of the operation of the Office of the Speaker of the House
 18 of Representatives, the Office of the Chief of Staff, the Office of the
 19 Coordinator of House Legislative Services, the Office of Parliamentarian, the
 20 Chief Clerk's Office, House Member Services Office and other reasonable and
 21 necessary expenses of the House of Representatives of the General Assembly
 22 incurred during the fiscal year ending June 30, ~~2016~~ 2017. Any balance
 23 remaining on June 30, ~~2015~~ 2016 in the funds provided by this Act shall be
 24 made available for the fiscal year ending June 30, ~~2016~~ 2017 and for the same
 25 purposes.
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27 SECTION 14. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS
 28 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. TRANSFER
 29 AUTHORITY. If the Speaker of the House and the Chief of Staff or his
 30 designee determine that any item or portion thereof appropriated herein for a
 31 specific purpose is not needed for such purpose, they may certify such fact
 32 to the State Auditor and the State Auditor shall cause a transfer to be made
 33 from one item to another.
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35 SECTION 15. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS
 36 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. SALARIES.

1 In order that exceptionally well-qualified personnel may be recruited and
2 retained, the House of Representatives may exceed the maximum salary levels
3 by no more than twenty percent (20%) for no more than one-third (1/3) of the
4 positions authorized in their operation appropriation act, may exceed the
5 maximum salary levels for the purpose of merit adjustments for all positions,
6 and may promote a maximum of two grades for no more than one-third (1/3) of
7 the classified positions authorized in its operation appropriation act.

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9 SECTION 16. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS
10 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW.

11 AUDIO/VISUAL POLICY. The appropriations provided herein to produce audio or
12 video materials by or under the direction of the House of Representatives
13 shall not be used for the following:

14 (a) A person may not use audio or video materials produced by or under the
15 direction of the House of Representatives in political or campaign
16 advertising.

17 (b) A person may not use audio or video materials produced by or under the
18 direction of the House of Representatives for a commercial purpose.

19 (1) In this section, "commercial purpose" means a purpose that is
20 intended to result in a profit or other tangible benefit.

21 (c) The House Management Committee may give permission to an entity to use
22 the audio or video materials for public education governmental
23 broadcast which shall not conflict with subsection (b).

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25 SECTION 17. COMPLIANCE WITH OTHER LAWS. Disbursement of funds
26 authorized by this act shall be limited to the appropriation for such agency
27 and funds made available by law for the support of such appropriations; and
28 the restrictions of the State Procurement Law, the General Accounting and
29 Budgetary Procedures Law, the Revenue Stabilization Law, the Regular Salary
30 Procedures and Restrictions Act, or their successors, and other fiscal
31 control laws of this State, where applicable, and regulations promulgated by
32 the Department of Finance and Administration, as authorized by law, shall be
33 strictly complied with in disbursement of said funds.

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35 SECTION 18. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General
36 Assembly that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations

1 contained in this act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for
2 which this act was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive
3 Recommendations and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget
4 manuals prepared by the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or
5 summarized oral testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative
6 Council or Joint Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption.
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8 SECTION 19. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the
9 General Assembly, that the Constitution of the State of Arkansas prohibits
10 the appropriation of funds for more than a one (1) year period; that the
11 effectiveness of this Act on July 1, 2016 is essential to the operation of
12 the agency for which the appropriations in this Act are provided, and that in
13 the event of an extension of the legislative session, the delay in the
14 effective date of this Act beyond July 1, 2016 could work irreparable harm
15 upon the proper administration and provision of essential governmental
16 programs. Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act
17 being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health
18 and safety shall be in full force and effect from and after July 1, 2016.
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
