There is hereby appropriated, to the Department of 8 Arkansas Heritage - Historic Preservation, to be payable from the General 9 Improvement Fund or its successor fund or fund accounts, for the Department 10 of Arkansas Heritage - Historic Preservation the following:

11 (A) Effective July 1, 2016, the balance of the appropriation provided 12 in Item (A) Section 1 of Act 415 of 2015, for land acquisition and 13 improvement of the historic Elkin's Ferry Battlefield near Prescott, 14 Arkansas, in a sum not to exceed.....\$30,000. 15

16 SECTION 18. DISBURSEMENT CONTROLS. (A) No contract may be awarded nor 17 obligations otherwise incurred in relation to the project or projects 18 described herein in excess of the State Treasury funds actually available 19 therefor as provided by law. Provided, however, that institutions and 20 agencies listed herein shall have the authority to accept and use grants and 21 donations including Federal funds, and to use its unobligated cash income or 22 funds, or both available to it, for the purpose of supplementing the State 23 Treasury funds for financing the entire costs of the project or projects 24 enumerated herein. Provided further, that the appropriations and funds 25 otherwise provided by the General Assembly for Maintenance and General 26 Operations of the agency or institutions receiving appropriation herein shall 27 not be used for any of the purposes as appropriated in this act.

(B) The restrictions of any applicable provisions of the State Purchasing Law, the General Accounting and Budgetary Procedures Law, the Revenue Stabilization Law and any other applicable fiscal control laws of this State and regulations promulgated by the Department of Finance and Administration, as authorized by law, shall be strictly complied with in disbursement of any funds provided by this act unless specifically provided otherwise by law.

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SECTION 19. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General

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Assembly that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations contained in this act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for which this act was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive Recommendations and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget manuals prepared by the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or summarized oral testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative Council or Joint Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption.

9 SECTION 20. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the 10 General Assembly, that the Constitution of the State of Arkansas prohibits 11 the appropriation of funds for more than a one (1) year period; that the effectiveness of this Act on July 1, 2016 is essential to the operation of 12 the agency for which the appropriations in this Act are provided, and that in 13 the event of an extension of the legislative session, the delay in the 14 15 effective date of this Act beyond July 1, 2016 could work irreparable harm 16 upon the proper administration and provision of essential governmental 17 programs. Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act 18 being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health 19 and safety shall be in full force and effect from and after July 1, 2016. 20 21 22 23 24 25 26 27 28 29 30 31 32 33 34 35

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
