NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS 9 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. 10 11 DEVELOPMENTAL DISABILITIES - TIMBER SALES PROCEEDS - CAPITAL IMPROVEMENTS AND 12 EQUIPMENT. The Division of Developmental Disabilities Services is authorized 13 to use the administrative operating accounts for capital improvements to 14 physical plants and for the purchase of capital equipment. The funds shall be 15 held by the Department of Human Services, Division of Developmental 16 Disabilities Services from the proceeds of the sale of timber that may be 17 harvested from land owned by the Division of Developmental Disabilities 18 Services. All funds deposited and all expenses shall be tracked separately. 19 The harvesting of timber is specifically authorized to provide funds to 20 finance capital improvements to the physical plants and for the purchase of 21 major capital equipment.

The Division of Developmental Disabilities Services shall report all income derived from timber management to the Chief Fiscal Officer of the State and the Arkansas Legislative Council. Any contracts initiated for the harvesting of timber shall be submitted to the Review Subcommittee of the Arkansas Legislative Council for prior review. All expenditures of funds derived from the sale of timber will be expended in accordance with relevant state purchasing laws.

SECTION 15. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS

 DEVELOPMENT CENTERS AND COMMUNITY PROVIDERS.

35 (A) The Developmental Disabilities Services Board or the Department of36 Human Services shall not close any of the state administered Human

1 Development Centers which are located at Conway, Arkadelphia, Jonesboro,

2 Booneville, and Warren.

3 (B) The Department of Human Services shall continue to accept clients for 4 whom it has determined that therapy and residential services are needed at 5 state administered Human Development Centers and Community Programs licensed 6 by DDS shall continue to accept clients for whom it has been determined in 7 accordance with federal law that are in need of services in the community.

8 (C) Except for use as federal matching funds, no funds for community based 9 services licensed by DDS shall be transferred from Grants to Community 10 Providers line item of the Developmental Disabilities Services - Grants-in-11 Aid appropriation unless the transfer(s) directly benefit(s) community based 12 services for persons with developmental disabilities or from the 13 appropriation for the Human Development Centers unless the transfer(s) 14 directly benefit(s) the Human Development Centers.

15 (D) Nor shall any general revenue funding as of July 1, 2015 2016 from the 16 Grants to Community Providers line item of the Developmental Disabilities 17 Services - Grants-in-Aid appropriation for persons with developmental 18 disabilities or from any other general revenues as of July 1, 2015 2016, 19 applied as federal matching funds for community based services licensed by 20 DDS on July 1, 2015 2016 be reduced below the approved funding level on July 21 1, 2015 2016; nor shall the general revenues applied as federal matching 22 funds for the Human Development Centers be reduced below the approved funding 23 level on July 1, 2015 2016.

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27 SECTION 16. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS 28 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. AUTISM 29 TREATMENT AND COORDINATION. The Department of Human Services - Division of 30 Developmental Disabilities Services shall promulgate rules and regulations 31 regarding the licensure and oversight of Applied Behavior Analysts as 32 described in Arkansas Code § 23-99-418. The rules and regulations shall 33 include a requirement for a licensure application fee equal to that charged 34 to applicants to be licensed as a psychologist as described in Arkansas Code 35 § 17-97-309. Proceeds from this fee are declared as cash funds. 36 The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1, 2015

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- 2016 through June 30, 2016 2017.
- SECTION 17. COMPLIANCE WITH OTHER LAWS. Disbursement of funds 3 4 authorized by this act shall be limited to the appropriation for such agency 5 and funds made available by law for the support of such appropriations; and 6 the restrictions of the State Procurement Law, the General Accounting and 7 Budgetary Procedures Law, the Revenue Stabilization Law, the Regular Salary 8 Procedures and Restrictions Act, or their successors, and other fiscal 9 control laws of this State, where applicable, and regulations promulgated by 10 the Department of Finance and Administration, as authorized by law, shall be 11 strictly complied with in disbursement of said funds. 12 13 SECTION 18. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General 14 Assembly that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations 15 contained in this act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for 16 which this act was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive 17 Recommendations and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget 18 manuals prepared by the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or 19 summarized oral testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative 20 Council or Joint Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption. 21 22 SECTION 19. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the 23 General Assembly, that the Constitution of the State of Arkansas prohibits 24 the appropriation of funds for more than a one (1) year period; that the effectiveness of this Act on July 1, 2016 is essential to the operation of 25 26 the agency for which the appropriations in this Act are provided, and that in 27 the event of an extension of the legislative session, the delay in the effective date of this Act beyond July 1, 2016 could work irreparable harm 28 29 upon the proper administration and provision of essential governmental 30 programs. Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health 31 32 and safety shall be in full force and effect from and after July 1, 2016. 33 34 35 36
