The Clerk of the State Claims Commission is hereby made 21 the disbursing officer for the purpose of paying the claims appropriated by 22 The Clerk of the State Claims Commission is hereby authorized to 23 receive all warrants prepared under the provisions of this Act from the 24 Auditor of State and to distribute same to the claimants. 25 26 SECTION 15. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS 27 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. ARKANSAS 28 DEPARTMENT OF HUMAN SERVICES CLAIMS. For any claims in this Act appropriated 29 to the Department of Human Services, the Clerk of the State Claims Commission 30 shall consult with the Department of Human Services and the Chief Fiscal 31 Officer of the State to determine the division and funds to which liability 32 should be assigned and from which the warrants shall be drawn. - 2 DEPARTMENT OF HEALTH CLAIMS. For any claims in this Act appropriated to the
- 3 Department of Health, the Clerk of the State Claims Commission shall consult

- 6 from which the warrants shall be drawn. The Clerk of the State Claims

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10 SECTION 17. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS 11 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. CLAIMS 12 FROM CASH FUNDS. In the event that any claim authorized herein is determined 13 to be a valid claim against the State and the claim is to be paid from funds 14 not in the State Treasury, the Clerk of the State Claims Commission shall 15 notify the agency against which the claim is to be charged of the amount of 16 such claims. Upon receipt of such notification, the state agency shall 17 forth-with deliver a check to the Clerk of the State Claims Commission who 18 shall deposit the same as a nonrevenue receipt into the Miscellaneous 19 Revolving Fund from which he shall disburse the amount of the claim to the

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claimant.

22 SECTION 18. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS 23 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. 24 EMPLOYMENT COMPENSATION CLAIMS. The Clerk of the State Claims Commission 25 shall not distribute any warrants prepared under the provisions of this Act 26 for awards made by the Arkansas State Claims Commission for employment 27 compensation claims. Upon the award by the State Claims Commission of an 28 employment compensation claim, the Clerk of the State Claims Commission shall 29 notify the affected state agency and the Department of Finance and 30 Administration - Office of Personnel Management of such amounts that are due 31 and payable. The affected state agency shall then process the award through 32 the State Mechanized Payroll System.

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SECTION 19. COMPLIANCE WITH OTHER LAWS. Disbursement of funds authorized by this act shall be limited to the appropriation for such agency and funds made available by law for the support of such appropriations; and

1 the restrictions of the State Procurement Law, the General Accounting and 2 Budgetary Procedures Law, the Revenue Stabilization Law, the Regular Salary Procedures and Restrictions Act, or their successors, and other fiscal 3 4 control laws of this State, where applicable, and regulations promulgated by 5 the Department of Finance and Administration, as authorized by law, shall be 6 strictly complied with in disbursement of said funds. 7 8 SECTION 20. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General 9 Assembly that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations 10 contained in this act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for 11 which this act was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive 12 Recommendations and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget 13 manuals prepared by the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or 14 summarized oral testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative 15 Council or Joint Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption. 16 17 SECTION 21. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the 18 General Assembly, that payees listed in this Act may be entitled to the sums 19 appropriated and transferred to herein, and that they have been deprived of 20 the use of these funds for a long period of time, and that further delay in paying these just debts of the state would do harm to the reputation of the 21 22 State of Arkansas. Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and 23 this Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety shall be in full force and effect from and after the date 24 25 of its passage and approval. 26 If the bill is neither approved nor vetoed by the Governor, it shall become 27 effective on the expiration of the period of time during which the Governor may veto the bill. If the bill is vetoed by the Governor and the veto is 28 29 overridden, it shall become effective on the date the last house overrides 30 the veto. 31 32 33 34 35

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
