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22	SECTION 1. APPR	OPRIATION - PUBLIC/PRIVATE PARTNER	RSHIP GRANTS. There is	
23	hereby appropriated, to the Department of Workforce Services, to be payable			
24	from the Department of Workforce Services Trust Fund, for grants for			
25	public/private partnerships to enhance and provide workforce training by the

SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS 8 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. FEDERAL 9 TANF FUNDS TRANSFER. Immediately upon the effective date of this Act, the 10 Chief Fiscal Officer of the State shall transfer on his or her books and those of the State Treasurer and the Auditor of the State two hundred fifty 11 12 thousand dollars (\$250,000) from the federal funding received from the 13 Temporary Assistance for Needy Families grant funding from the U.S. 14 Department of Health and Human Services to the Department of Workforce 15 Services Trust Fund to be used exclusively for Public/Private Partnership 16 Grants of the Department of Workforce Services for the 2016-2017 fiscal year. 17 SECTION 4. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS 18 19 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. CHILDREN 20 AND FAMILY SERVICES FUND TRANSFER. Immediately upon the effective date of 21 this Act, the Chief Fiscal Officer of the State shall transfer on his or her 22 books and those of the State Treasurer and the Auditor of the State two 23 hundred fifty thousand dollars (\$250,000) from the Department of Human 24 Services - Children and Family Services Fund Account to the Department of 25 Workforce Services Trust Fund to be used exclusively for Public/Private Partnership Grants of the Department of Workforce Services for the 2016-2017 26 27 fiscal year. 28 SECTION 5. COMPLIANCE WITH OTHER LAWS. Disbursement of funds 29 authorized by this act shall be limited to the appropriation for such agency 30 31 and funds made available by law for the support of such appropriations; and 32 the restrictions of the State Procurement Law, the General Accounting and 33 Budgetary Procedures Law, the Revenue Stabilization Law, the Regular Salary

34 Procedures and Restrictions Act, or their successors, and other fiscal 35 control laws of this State, where applicable, and regulations promulgated by 36 the Department of Finance and Administration, as authorized by law, shall be

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- 1 strictly complied with in disbursement of said funds.
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3 SECTION 6. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General 4 Assembly that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations 5 contained in this act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for 6 which this act was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive Recommendations and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget 7 8 manuals prepared by the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or 9 summarized oral testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative 10 Council or Joint Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption. 11 12 SECTION 7. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the General 13 Assembly, that the Constitution of the State of Arkansas prohibits the 14 appropriation of funds for more than a one (1) year period; that the 15 effectiveness of this Act on July 1, 2016 is essential to the operation of 16 the agency for which the appropriations in this Act are provided, and that in 17 the event of an extension of the legislative session, the delay in the effective date of this Act beyond July 1, 2016 could work irreparable harm 18 19 upon the proper administration and provision of essential governmental 20 programs. Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health 21 22 and safety shall be in full force and effect from and after July 1, 2016. 23 24 25 26
