8 AN ACT TO REAPPROPRIATE THE BALANCES OF CAPITAL
9 IMPROVEMENT APPROPRIATIONS FOR THE SECRETARY OF
10 STATE; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

13 AN ACT FOR THE SECRETARY OF STATE
14 REAPPROPRIATION.
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18 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:
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20 SECTION 1. REAPPROPRIATION - CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT PROJECTS. There is
21 hereby appropriated, to the Secretary of State, to be payable from the
22 General Improvement Fund or its successor fund or fund accounts, for the
23 Secretary of State the following:

24 (A) Effective July 1, 2016, the balance of the appropriation provided
25 in Item (A) Section 1 of Act 151 of 2015, for HVAC upgrade to North End of
26 State Capitol building, in a sum not to exceed.....\$6,500,000.

27 (B) Effective July 1, 2016, the balance of the appropriation provided
28 in Item (B) Section 1 of Act 151 of 2015, for roof and window repair of the
29 State Capitol building, in a sum not to exceed.....\$2,500,000.

30 (C) Effective July 1, 2016, the balance of the appropriation provided
31 in Item (C) Section 1 of Act 151 of 2015, for asphalt resurfacing,
32 replacement of damaged sidewalks and curbs, addition of lighting to unlit or
33 dark areas, an upgrade of the irrigation system, and landscaping and
34 plantings for the North Entry Promenade I and II of the State Capitol
35 Grounds, in a sum not to exceed.....\$538,112.

36 (D) Effective July 1, 2016, the balance of the appropriation provided



1 in Item (D) Section 1 of Act 151 of 2015, for drains and storm water system
2 renovations of the State Capitol Grounds, in a sum not to exceed
3\$483,000.

4 (E) Effective July 1, 2016, the balance of the appropriation provided
5 in Item (E) Section 1 of Act 151 of 2015, for maintenance of State Capitol
6 restroom facilities, in a sum not to exceed.....\$500,000.

7 (F) Effective July 1, 2016, the balance of the appropriation provided
8 in Item (F) Section 1 of Act 151 of 2015, for interior plumbing and sump pump
9 replacement for the State Capitol building, in a sum not to exceed
10\$108,393.

11 (G) Effective July 1, 2016, the balance of the appropriation provided
12 in Item (G) Section 1 of Act 151 of 2015, for electrical panel replacement in
13 the State Capitol building, in a sum not to exceed.....\$212,980.

14 (H) Effective July 1, 2016, the balance of the appropriation provided
15 in Item (H) Section 1 of Act 151 of 2015, for expenses for State Capitol as-
16 built drawings, in a sum not to exceed.....\$250,000.

17 (I) Effective July 1, 2016, the balance of the appropriation provided
18 in Item (I) Section 1 of Act 151 of 2015, for "Green" Initiatives for the
19 State Capitol building, facilities and grounds including ventilation system
20 cleaning, energy efficiency improvements and assessment, analysis and
21 consulting services, recycling programs and/or related construction,
22 renovation and equipping of and/or conversion to or purchase of Compressed
23 Natural Gas vehicles and equipment including installation of a refueling
24 station, in a sum not to exceed.....\$1,500,000.

25 (J) Effective July 1, 2016, the balance of the appropriation provided
26 in Item (J) Section 1 of Act 151 of 2015, for replacement of voting machine
27 equipment statewide, in a sum not to exceed.....\$30,000,000.

28 (K) Effective July 1, 2016, the balance of the appropriation provided
29 in Item (K) Section 1 of Act 151 of 2015, for stone restoration, cleaning and
30 repointing on the East Side of the State Capitol building, in a sum not to
31 exceed.....\$3,500,000.

32 (L) Effective July 1, 2016, the balance of the appropriation provided
33 in Item (P) Section 1 of Act 395 of 2015, for construction of Phase II of the
34 Arkansas Fallen Firefighters' Memorial on the State Capitol grounds or for
35 upkeep, maintenance, preservation and repair of all Monuments and Memorials
36 on the grounds of the State Capitol, in a sum not to exceed.....\$4,776.

1 (M) Effective July 1, 2016, the balance of the appropriation provided
2 in Item (Q) Section 1 of Act 395 of 2015, for construction, site preparation
3 and maintenance of the Arkansas Fallen Firefighters' Memorial on the State
4 Capitol Grounds or for upkeep, maintenance, preservation and repair of all
5 Monuments and Memorials on the grounds of the State Capitol, in a sum not to
6 exceed.....\$49,400.

7 (N) Effective July 1, 2016, the balance of the appropriation provided
8 in Item (A) Section 1 of Act 663 of 2015, for operating expenses and
9 professional fees and services for computer upgrades and development for the
10 On-Line Campaign Finance Reporting System, in a sum not to exceed
11\$40,000.

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13 SECTION 2. REAPPROPRIATION - NATURAL AND CULTURAL RESOURCES COUNCIL -
14 STATE OWNED LANDS OR HISTORIC SITES. There is hereby appropriated, to the
15 Secretary of State, to be payable from the Arkansas Natural and Cultural
16 Resources Grant and Trust Fund, for the Secretary of State the following:

17 (A) Effective July 1, 2016, the balance of the appropriation provided
18 in Section 29 of Act 718 of 2015, for the acquisition, management,
19 stewardship or preservation of state owned lands, historic sites, buildings,
20 structures or objects, in a sum not to exceed.....\$1,000,000.

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22 SECTION 3. DISBURSEMENT CONTROLS. (A) No contract may be awarded nor
23 obligations otherwise incurred in relation to the project or projects
24 described herein in excess of the State Treasury funds actually available
25 therefor as provided by law. Provided, however, that institutions and
26 agencies listed herein shall have the authority to accept and use grants and
27 donations including Federal funds, and to use its unobligated cash income or
28 funds, or both available to it, for the purpose of supplementing the State
29 Treasury funds for financing the entire costs of the project or projects
30 enumerated herein. Provided further, that the appropriations and funds
31 otherwise provided by the General Assembly for Maintenance and General
32 Operations of the agency or institutions receiving appropriation herein shall
33 not be used for any of the purposes as appropriated in this act.

34 (B) The restrictions of any applicable provisions of the State
35 Purchasing Law, the General Accounting and Budgetary Procedures Law, the
36 Revenue Stabilization Law and any other applicable fiscal control laws of

1 this State and regulations promulgated by the Department of Finance and
2 Administration, as authorized by law, shall be strictly complied with in
3 disbursement of any funds provided by this act unless specifically provided
4 otherwise by law.

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6 SECTION 4. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General
7 Assembly that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations
8 contained in this act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for
9 which this act was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive
10 Recommendations and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget
11 manuals prepared by the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or
12 summarized oral testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative
13 Council or Joint Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption.
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15 SECTION 5. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the General
16 Assembly, that the Constitution of the State of Arkansas prohibits the
17 appropriation of funds for more than a one (1) year period; that the
18 effectiveness of this Act on July 1, 2016 is essential to the operation of
19 the agency for which the appropriations in this Act are provided, and that in
20 the event of an extension of the legislative session, the delay in the
21 effective date of this Act beyond July 1, 2016 could work irreparable harm
22 upon the proper administration and provision of essential governmental
23 programs. Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act
24 being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health
25 and safety shall be in full force and effect from and after July 1, 2016.
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
