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20 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:
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22 SECTION 1. REGULAR SALARIES. There is hereby established for the
23 Arkansas Geographic Information Systems Office for the 2016-2017 fiscal year,

 24 appropriated, to the Arkansas Geographic Information Systems Office, to be
 25 payable from the Geographic Information Systems Fund, to carry out the
 26 duties, responsibilities and authority of the Arkansas State Land Information
 27 Board as described by Arkansas Code 15-21-504; to create, operate and
 28 maintain Geostor, the Arkansas Spatial Data Infrastructure and to create,
 29 update, maintain and disseminate framework spatial data as defined by
 30 Arkansas Code 15-21-502 for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2017, the

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SECTION 4. APPROPRIATION - PARCEL MAPPING GRANT. There is hereby appropriated, to the Arkansas Geographic Information Systems Office, to be payable from the Geographic Information Systems Fund, for expenses of implementing and administering the Statewide Mapping Grant Program by the Arkansas Geographic Information Systems Office for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2017, the following:

SECTION 5. APPROPRIATION - MOVING AHEAD FOR PROGRESS - 21ST CENTURY. There is hereby appropriated, to the Arkansas Geographic Information Systems Office, to be payable from the federal funds as designated by the Chief Fiscal Officer of the State, for operating expenses for the implementation of a referencing system including road class, road design, and surface type of the Arkansas Geographic Information Systems Office for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2017, the following:

SECTION 6. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. TRANSFER OF CARRY FORWARD. Any unexpended balance of funds remaining on June 30 of each fiscal year in the Miscellaneous Agencies Fund Account for the Arkansas Geographic Information Office, shall be transferred to the Geographic Information Systems Fund to be used for operating and maintaining the Arkansas Spatial Data Infrastructure, creating, updating, maintaining and disseminating framework spatial data as defined by Arkansas Code §15-21-502.

1 (1) Prior to June 30, ~~2016~~ 2017 the Agency shall by written statement set
2 forth its reason(s) for the need to carry forward said funding to the
3 Department of Finance and Administration Office of Budget;

4 (2) The Department of Finance and Administration Office of Budget shall
5 report to the Arkansas Legislative Council all amounts carried forward by the
6 September Arkansas Legislative Council or Joint Budget Committee meeting
7 which report shall include the name of the Agency, Board, Commission or
8 Institution and the amount of the funding carried forward, the program name
9 or line item, the funding source of that appropriation and a copy of the
10 written request set forth in (1) above;

11 (3) Each Agency, Board, Commission or Institution shall provide a written
12 report to the Arkansas Legislative Council or Joint Budget Committee
13 containing all information set forth in item (2) above, along with a written
14 statement as to the current status of the project, contract, purpose etc. for
15 which the carry forward was originally requested no later than thirty (30)
16 days prior to the time the Agency, Board, Commission or Institution presents
17 its budget request to the Arkansas Legislative Council/Joint Budget
18 Committee; and

19 (4) Thereupon, the Department of Finance and Administration shall include
20 all information obtained in item (3) above in the biennial budget manuals
21 and/or a statement of non-compliance by the Agency, Board, Commission or
22 Institution.

23 The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1, ~~2015~~
24 2016 through June 30, ~~2016~~ 2017.

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26 SECTION 7. COMPLIANCE WITH OTHER LAWS. Disbursement of funds
27 authorized by this act shall be limited to the appropriation for such agency
28 and funds made available by law for the support of such appropriations; and
29 the restrictions of the State Procurement Law, the General Accounting and
30 Budgetary Procedures Law, the Revenue Stabilization Law, the Regular Salary
31 Procedures and Restrictions Act, or their successors, and other fiscal
32 control laws of this State, where applicable, and regulations promulgated by
33 the Department of Finance and Administration, as authorized by law, shall be
34 strictly complied with in disbursement of said funds.

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36 SECTION 8. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General

1 Assembly that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations
2 contained in this act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for
3 which this act was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive
4 Recommendations and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget
5 manuals prepared by the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or
6 summarized oral testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative
7 Council or Joint Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption.
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9 SECTION 9. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the General
10 Assembly, that the Constitution of the State of Arkansas prohibits the
11 appropriation of funds for more than a one (1) year period; that the
12 effectiveness of this Act on July 1, 2016 is essential to the operation of
13 the agency for which the appropriations in this Act are provided, and that in
14 the event of an extension of the legislative session, the delay in the
15 effective date of this Act beyond July 1, 2016 could work irreparable harm
16 upon the proper administration and provision of essential governmental
17 programs. Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act
18 being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health
19 and safety shall be in full force and effect from and after July 1, 2016.
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
