## For An Act To Be Entitled

8 AN ACT TO MAKE AN APPROPRIATION FOR PERSONAL SERVICES  
9 AND OPERATING EXPENSES FOR THE ARKANSAS GEOGRAPHIC  
10 INFORMATION SYSTEMS OFFICE FOR THE FISCAL YEAR ENDING  
11 JUNE 30, 2017; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

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### Subtitle

14 AN ACT FOR THE ARKANSAS GEOGRAPHIC  
15 INFORMATION SYSTEMS OFFICE APPROPRIATION  
16 FOR THE 2016-2017 FISCAL YEAR.  
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20 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:  
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22 SECTION 1. REGULAR SALARIES. There is hereby established for the  
23 Arkansas Geographic Information Systems Office for the 2016-2017 fiscal year,

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11 SECTION 5. APPROPRIATION - MOVING AHEAD FOR PROGRESS - 21ST CENTURY.

12 There is hereby appropriated, to the Arkansas Geographic Information Systems  
 13 Office, to be payable from the federal funds as designated by the Chief  
 14 Fiscal Officer of the State, for operating expenses for the implementation of  
 15 a referencing system including road class, road design, and surface type of  
 16 the Arkansas Geographic Information Systems Office for the fiscal year ending  
 17 June 30, 2017, the following:

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29 SECTION 6. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. TRANSFER OF CARRY FORWARD. Any unexpended  
 30 balance of funds remaining on June 30 of each fiscal year in the  
 31 Miscellaneous Agencies Fund Account for the Arkansas Geographic Information  
 32 Office, shall be transferred to the Geographic Information Systems Fund to be  
 33 used for operating and maintaining the Arkansas Spatial Data Infrastructure,  
 34 creating, updating, maintaining and disseminating framework spatial data as  
 35 defined by Arkansas Code §15-21-502.

36 (1) Prior to June 30, ~~2016~~ 2017 the Agency shall by written statement set

- 1 forth its reason(s) for the need to carry forward said funding to the  
2 Department of Finance and Administration Office of Budget;
- 3 (2) The Department of Finance and Administration Office of Budget shall  
4 report to the Arkansas Legislative Council all amounts carried forward by the  
5 September Arkansas Legislative Council or Joint Budget Committee meeting  
6 which report shall include the name of the Agency, Board, Commission or  
7 Institution and the amount of the funding carried forward, the program name  
8 or line item, the funding source of that appropriation and a copy of the  
9 written request set forth in (1) above;
- 10 (3) Each Agency, Board, Commission or Institution shall provide a written  
11 report to the Arkansas Legislative Council or Joint Budget Committee  
12 containing all information set forth in item (2) above, along with a written  
13 statement as to the current status of the project, contract, purpose etc. for  
14 which the carry forward was originally requested no later than thirty (30)  
15 days prior to the time the Agency, Board, Commission or Institution presents  
16 its budget request to the Arkansas Legislative Council/Joint Budget  
17 Committee; and
- 18 (4) Thereupon, the Department of Finance and Administration shall include  
19 all information obtained in item (3) above in the biennial budget manuals  
20 and/or a statement of non-compliance by the Agency, Board, Commission or  
21 Institution.

22 The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1, ~~2015~~  
23 2016 through June 30, ~~2016~~ 2017.

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25 SECTION 7. COMPLIANCE WITH OTHER LAWS. Disbursement of funds  
26 authorized by this act shall be limited to the appropriation for such agency  
27 and funds made available by law for the support of such appropriations; and  
28 the restrictions of the State Procurement Law, the General Accounting and  
29 Budgetary Procedures Law, the Revenue Stabilization Law, the Regular Salary  
30 Procedures and Restrictions Act, or their successors, and other fiscal  
31 control laws of this State, where applicable, and regulations promulgated by  
32 the Department of Finance and Administration, as authorized by law, shall be  
33 strictly complied with in disbursement of said funds.

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35 SECTION 8. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General  
36 Assembly that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations

1 contained in this act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for  
2 which this act was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive  
3 Recommendations and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget  
4 manuals prepared by the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or  
5 summarized oral testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative  
6 Council or Joint Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption.  
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8 SECTION 9. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the General  
9 Assembly, that the Constitution of the State of Arkansas prohibits the  
10 appropriation of funds for more than a one (1) year period; that the  
11 effectiveness of this Act on July 1, 2016 is essential to the operation of  
12 the agency for which the appropriations in this Act are provided, and that in  
13 the event of an extension of the legislative session, the delay in the  
14 effective date of this Act beyond July 1, 2016 could work irreparable harm  
15 upon the proper administration and provision of essential governmental  
16 programs. Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act  
17 being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health  
18 and safety shall be in full force and effect from and after July 1, 2016.
