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1 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. PARK 2 BUDGET ALLOCATION. Prior to July 1 of each fiscal year, the Legislative Council or the Joint Budget Committee shall review the Parks and Tourism 3 4 Department's plan for the upcoming year of amounts to be disbursed for each 5 park or other entity from the funds appropriated for State Operations of this 6 Act. The request for review from the agency shall include amounts to be 7 disbursed for each entity for the upcoming fiscal year compared to the 8 current fiscal year's anticipated expenditures and the previous fiscal year's 9 actual expenditures with any additional detail as may be required by the 10 reviewing body. The funds appropriated in Section 5 of this Act for Parks and 20 Tourism Special Maintenance shall be expended, after receiving prior approval 21 by the Arkansas Legislative Council or Joint Budget Committee, for a special 22 maintenance program for the Park System.
