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20 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:
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22 SECTION 1. APPROPRIATION. There is hereby appropriated, to the
23 Department of Education, to be payable from the Department of Education
24 Public School Fund Account, for grants and aid to local school districts and
25 special programs of the Department of Education for the fiscal year ending
26 June 30, 2017, the following:

 26 hereby appropriated, to the Department of Education, to be payable from the
 27 Department of Education Public School Fund Account, for personal services,
 28 operating expenses and grants by the Department of Education - Office of
 29 Education Renewal Zones for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2017, the

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9 SECTION 6. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS
 10 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. BROADBAND
 11 FACILITIES MATCHING GRANT PROGRAM - RESTRICTIONS AND MATCHING FUNDS. (i) The
 12 appropriation in this Act for the Broadband Facilities Matching Grant Program
 13 shall not be used for Arkansas Research and Education Optical Network (AREON)
 14 or Middle Mile Connectivity.

15 (ii) The funds appropriated for state match for the Broadband
 16 Facilities Matching Grant Program in this Act shall be paid on a one-to-one
 17 state/local matching basis.

18 The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1, ~~2015~~
 19 2016 through June 30, ~~2016~~ 2017.

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21 SECTION 7. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS
 22 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. BROADBAND
 23 FACILITIES MATCHING GRANT PROGRAM - CARRY FORWARD. Any unexpended balance of
 24 monies allocated for the Broadband Facilities Matching Grant Program
 25 remaining on June 30, ~~2016~~ 2017, in the Department of Education Public School
 26 Fund Account shall be designated and retained for the Broadband Facilities
 27 Matching Grant Program.

28 Any carry forward of unexpected balance of funding as authorized herein, may
 29 be carried forward under the following conditions:

30 (1) Prior to June 30, ~~2016~~ 2017 the Agency shall by written statement
 31 set forth its reason(s) for the need to carry forward said funding to the
 32 Department of Finance and Administration Office of Budget;

33 (2) The Department of Finance and Administration Office of Budget shall
 34 report to the Arkansas Legislative Council all amounts carried forward by the
 35 September Arkansas Legislative Council or Joint Budget Committee meeting
 36 which report shall include the name of the Agency, Board, Commission or

1 Institution and the amount of the funding carried forward, the program name
 2 or line item, the funding source of that appropriation and a copy of the
 3 written request set forth in item (1) above;

4 (3) Each Agency, Board, Commission or Institution shall provide a
 5 written report to the Arkansas Legislative Council or Joint Budget Committee
 6 containing all information set forth in item (2) above, along with a written
 7 statement as to the current status of the project, contract, purpose, etc.
 8 for which the carry forward was originally requested no later than thirty
 9 (30) days prior to the time the Agency, Board, Commission or Institution
 10 presents its budget request to the Arkansas Legislative Council/Joint Budget
 11 Committee; and

12 (4) Thereupon, the Department of Finance and Administration shall
 13 include all information obtained in item (3) above in the budget manuals
 14 and/or a statement of non-compliance by the Agency, Board, Commission or
 15 Institution.

16 The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1, ~~2015~~
 17 2016 through June 30, ~~2016~~ 2017.

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 19 SECTION 8. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS
 20 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. FUND
 21 ALLOCATION. The appropriation for the Isolated Funding line item in Section 1
 22 of this Act may be fully funded. Any funding and appropriation for Isolated
 23 Funding that is not utilized shall be transferred to the appropriation for
 24 Special Needs Isolated Funding in Section 1 of this Act and shall be used
 25 there for fully funding each subsection (c) through (f) of Arkansas Code
 26 §6-20-604 on a pro rata basis until the available funds are exhausted. Pro
 27 rata basis is defined as providing each district qualifying for additional
 28 funding under subsections (c) through (f) a proportionate share based on how
 29 each district's additional funding amount bears to the total additional
 30 funding amounts for all qualifying districts. If any funding and
 31 appropriation remains after funding each subsection (c) through (f) of
 32 Arkansas Code §6-20-604 the remaining balance shall be used to fund the
 33 provisions of Arkansas Code §6-20-604 (h) on an equal basis until the
 34 available funds are exhausted.

35 The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1, ~~2015~~
 36 2016 through June 30, ~~2016~~ 2017.

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2 SECTION 9. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS
3 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. GRANTS TO
4 SCHOOL DISTRICTS. For the purposes of distributing the Grants To School
5 Districts appropriation in Section 1 of this Act, "school district" means a
6 school district which contracts with a school district in an adjoining state
7 for the education of some of the pupils within the Arkansas school district
8 because the portion of the school district wherein such pupils live is
9 completely separated from the remainder of the school district by a reservoir
10 covering at least 12,000 acres at normal water level, and where to attend
11 school in their own district, the pupils of said portion would be required to
12 travel or to be transported a distance (measured by the nearest highway or
13 road route) of more than 35 miles round trip and pass through another school
14 district or districts. The Department of Education shall distribute the
15 monies appropriated for Grants to School Districts in Section 1 of this Act
16 to such school districts as reimbursement for expenses incurred in educating
17 the pupils residing in the separated portion of the school district. The
18 payments are to be limited to the amount of available appropriation. Such
19 school districts shall file a request for reimbursement with the Department
20 of Education and provide the Department of Education with such documentation
21 as is deemed necessary.

22 The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1, ~~2015~~
23 2016 through June 30, ~~2016~~ 2017.

24
25 SECTION 10. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS
26 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. SPECIAL
27 EDUCATION SERVICES. The funds appropriated in the line item "Special
28 Education Services" in Section 1 of this Act shall be used to provide
29 extended year summer programs for handicapped students in need of such
30 services, to provide special education services to foster children who are
31 wards of the State, and to provide funds for the payment of salaries of
32 special education supervisors. The Department of Education shall distribute
33 such funds in the manner necessary to carry out the intent of this Section.

34 The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1, ~~2015~~
35 2016 through June 30, ~~2016~~ 2017.

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1 SECTION 11. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS
2 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW.
3 DESEGREGATION EXPENSES. (A) For the fiscal year ending June 30, and for each
4 fiscal year thereafter, the Department of Education shall from time to time
5 as needed, certify to the State Treasurer and the Chief Fiscal Officer of the
6 State, the amount of funds disbursed or approved to be disbursed by the
7 Department of Education for desegregation expenses under any "Desegregation
8 Settlement Agreement". Upon the receipt of such certification, the State
9 Treasurer, after making those deductions as set out in Arkansas Code 19-5-
10 202(b)(2)(B), shall also deduct from the net general revenues the amount
11 certified and transfer this amount to the Department of Education Public
12 School Fund Account there to be used exclusively for payment of or
13 reimbursement for expenses incurred from the Department of Education Public
14 School Fund Account under any "Desegregation Settlement Agreement".

15 The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1, ~~2015~~
16 2016 through June 30, ~~2016~~ 2017.

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18 SECTION 12. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS
19 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW.
20 CONSOLIDATION INCENTIVE. The appropriation contained herein for Consolidation
21 Incentive shall be allocated in accordance with rules and regulations
22 established by the State Board of Education.

23 The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1, ~~2015~~
24 2016 through June 30, ~~2016~~ 2017.

25
26 SECTION 13. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS
27 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW.
28 RESIDENTIAL CENTERS/JUVENILE DETENTION. The funds appropriated herein for
29 Residential Centers/Juvenile Detention shall be allocated in accordance with
30 rules and regulations established by the State Board of Education.

31 The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1, ~~2015~~
32 2016 through June 30, ~~2016~~ 2017.

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34 SECTION 14. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS
35 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. TRANSFER
36 AUTHORITY. The Commissioner of the Department of Education, with the approval

1 of the Chief Fiscal Officer of the State and after approval by the Arkansas
2 Legislative Council or Joint Budget Committee, is hereby authorized to
3 request necessary appropriation transfers and any other budget related
4 adjustments necessary within the Department of Education. Provided, however,
5 that the Department of Education shall be limited to submitting no more than
6 two transfer requests during any fiscal year.

7 Determining the maximum number of employees and the maximum amount of
8 appropriation and general revenue funding for a state agency each fiscal year
9 is the prerogative of the General Assembly. This is usually accomplished by
10 delineating such maximums in the appropriation act(s) for a state agency and
11 the general revenue allocations authorized for each fund and fund account by
12 amendment to the Revenue Stabilization law. Further, the General Assembly
13 has determined that the Department of Education may operate more efficiently
14 if some flexibility is provided to the Commissioner of the Department of
15 Education authorizing broad powers under the Transfer Authority provision
16 herein. Therefore, it is both necessary and appropriate that the General
17 Assembly maintain oversight by requiring prior approval of the Legislative
18 Council or Joint Budget Committee as provided by this section. The
19 requirement of approval by the Legislative Council or Joint Budget Committee
20 is not a severable part of this section. If the requirement of approval by
21 the Legislative Council or Joint Budget Committee is ruled unconstitutional
22 by a court jurisdiction, this entire section is void.

23 The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1, ~~2015~~
24 2016 through June 30, ~~2016~~ 2017.

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26 SECTION 15. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS
27 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. AETN
28 DOCUMENTED QUIZ BOWL COSTS. Of the total amount of appropriation and funds
29 authorized herein to the Department of Education for the Quiz Bowl each
30 fiscal year, an amount not to exceed forty thousand dollars (\$40,000) each
31 fiscal year may be made available to the Department of Education -
32 Educational Television Division for its documented costs associated with the
33 Quiz Bowl.

34 The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1, ~~2015~~
35 2016 through June 30, ~~2016~~ 2017.

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1 SECTION 16. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS
 2 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW.
 3 DISTRESSED SCHOOL DISTRICT SUPPORT. The funds appropriated in the line item
 4 "Distressed School District Support" in Section 1 of this Act may be used for
 5 technical assistance offered by the Department of Education to school
 6 districts in academic distress that can include, but is not limited to,
 7 teacher specialists, principal specialists, and other personnel assigned by
 8 the department. These funds may also be used for alternative research-based
 9 technical assistance or programs. Criteria for selecting and approving
 10 alternative research-based technical assistance or programs are to be
 11 promulgated as a rule by the State Board of Education, provided that
 12 alternative staffing and/or compensation programs for teachers shall be
 13 approved by at least a majority of the teachers in the school, schools, or
 14 school district participating in the program.

15 The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1, ~~2015~~
 16 2016 through June 30, ~~2016~~ 2017.

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 18 SECTION 17. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS
 19 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW.
 20 RETIREMENT MATCHING. Beginning with the 1996-97 school year, Local School
 21 Districts shall pay the teacher retirement employer contribution rate for any
 22 eligible employee in accordance with rules and regulations established by the
 23 Teacher Retirement Board of Directors. The appropriation contained herein for
 24 Teacher Retirement Matching each fiscal year shall be used to provide the
 25 employer matching for employees of the Cooperative Education Services Areas,
 26 Vocational Centers, Arkansas Easter Seals and the school operated by the
 27 Department of Correction.

28 The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1, ~~2015~~
 29 2016 through June 30, ~~2016~~ 2017.

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 31 SECTION 18. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS
 32 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. BETTER
 33 CHANCE PROGRAM ADMINISTRATIVE FEES. The Department of Education is hereby
 34 authorized to expend a maximum of two percent (2%) of available funds for
 35 administration of the Better Chance Program. Up to 1.8% of available funds
 36 shall be used to administer the program and to monitor program grantees to

1 ensure compliance with programmatic standards. Prior to the utilization of
2 the remaining 0.2% of available funds, the Department of Education shall seek
3 prior review and approval of the Arkansas Legislative Council or Joint Budget
4 Committee by providing a written request to include the following: a) the
5 Department's reason(s) for the use of the funds and b) the amount of funds
6 that will be expended. The Department may contract with the Division of Child
7 Care and Early Childhood Education to administer the program.

8 Determining the maximum number of employees and the maximum amount of
9 appropriation and general revenue funding for a state agency each fiscal year
10 is the prerogative of the General Assembly. This is usually accomplished by
11 delineating such maximums in the appropriation act(s) for a state agency and
12 the general revenue allocations authorized for each fund and fund account by
13 amendment to the Revenue Stabilization law. Therefore, it is both necessary
14 and appropriate that the General Assembly maintain oversight by requiring
15 prior approval of the Legislative Council or Joint Budget Committee as
16 provided by this section. The requirement of approval by the Legislative
17 Council or Joint Budget Committee is not a severable part of this section.
18 If the requirement of approval by the Legislative Council or Joint Budget
19 Committee is ruled unconstitutional by a court of competent jurisdiction,
20 this entire section is void.

21 The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1, ~~2015~~

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24 SECTION 19. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS
25 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. AVERAGE
26 TEACHER SALARY. The Arkansas Department of Education is requested to
27 calculate Average Teacher Salary in the Department's Annual Statistical
28 Report to not include extra duty funds. Specifically, the Department is
29 requested to calculate the Average Teacher Salary amount using the National
30 Education Association definitions for Average Salary for Classroom Teachers.
31 The Arkansas Department of Education shall submit this data annually to the
32 National Education Association in accordance with that organization's
33 deadlines for submission for their report "Rankings and Estimates" which
34 includes state-by-state teacher salary comparisons.

35 The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1, ~~2015~~
36 2016 through June 30, ~~2016~~ 2017.

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 2 SECTION 20. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS
 3 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. CARRY
 4 FORWARD - ARKANSAS BETTER CHANCE. Any unexpended balance of monies allocated
 5 for the Arkansas Better Chance for School Success Program remaining on June
 6 30, ~~2016~~ 2017, in the Department of Education Public School Fund Account
 7 shall be designated and retained for the Arkansas Better Chance for School
 8 Success Program.

9 Any carry forward of unexpended balance of funding as authorized herein,
 10 may be carried forward under the following conditions:

11 (1) Prior to June 30, ~~2016~~ 2017 the Agency shall by written statement set
 12 forth its reason(s) for the need to carry forward said funding to the
 13 Department of Finance and Administration Office of Budget;

14 (2) The Department of Finance and Administration Office of Budget shall
 15 report to the Arkansas Legislative Council all amounts carried forward by the
 16 September Arkansas Legislative Council or Joint Budget Committee meeting
 17 which report shall include the name of the Agency, Board, Commission or

 20 written request set forth in (1) above;

21 (3) Each Agency, Board, Commission or Institution shall provide a written
 22 report to the Arkansas Legislative Council or Joint Budget Committee
 23 containing all information set forth in item (2) above, along with a written
 24 statement as to the current status of the project, contract, purpose etc. for
 25 which the carry forward was originally requested no later than thirty (30)
 26 days prior to the time the Agency, Board, Commission or Institution presents
 27 its budget request to the Arkansas Legislative Council/Joint Budget
 28 Committee; and

29 (4) Thereupon, the Department of Finance and Administration shall include
 30 all information obtained in item (3) above in the budget manuals and/or a
 31 statement of non-compliance by the Agency, Board, Commission or Institution.

 35 SECTION 21. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS
 36 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. PUBLIC

1 SCHOOL RETIREE HEALTH INSURANCE. The Employee Benefits Division of the
2 Department of Finance and Administration may use up to eleven dollars and
3 twenty cents (\$11.20) from each contribution made under Arkansas Code
4 §6-17-1117(a) to offset the cost of health insurance premiums to eligible
5 members electing to participate in the public school employees' health
6 insurance program as a retiree.

7 The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1, ~~2015~~
8 2016 through June 30, ~~2016~~ 2017.

9
10 SECTION 22. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS
11 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW.
12 ARKANSAS/STRIVE PROGRAM TRANSFER. The Chief Fiscal Officer of the State
13 shall transfer on his books and those of the State Treasurer and the State
14 Auditor, the sum of two hundred thousand dollars (\$200,000) during each
15 fiscal year from the Department of Education Public School Fund Account to
16 the University of Arkansas at Little Rock Fund, specifically to provide
17 funding for the Arkansas/STRIVE Program. The total amount of funds
18 transferred each fiscal year pursuant to this section shall not be subject to
19 any indirect costs by the University of Arkansas at Little Rock.

20 The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1, ~~2015~~

23 SECTION 23. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS

25 INSURANCE. The appropriation contained herein for Public School Employee
26 Insurance each fiscal year shall be used to provide the state contribution
27 for insurance premiums for employees of the Cooperative Education Services
28 Areas, Vocational Centers, and the school operated by the Department of
29 Correction who participate in the Arkansas Public School Life and Health
30 Insurance Program.

31 The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1, ~~2015~~

34 SECTION 24. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS

36 ALTERNATIVE LEARNING ENVIRONMENT. The Department of Education may provide

1 funding for Alternative Learning Environment Programs in excess of the

 3 operate more than twelve hours per day, in a proportionate manner and upon
 4 special request to the Department of Education.

 8 SECTION 25. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS

 10 FUND RESTRICTIONS. No state funds shall be used for abortion referral in
 11 public schools, or for abortion services. Funds shall be expended in
 12 accordance with Arkansas Code Annotated §6-18-703.

 16 SECTION 26. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS

18 ADDITIONAL PUBLIC SCHOOL EMPLOYEE HEALTH INSURANCE FUNDING PROVISION.

19 Effective for the plan year beginning January 1, ~~2015~~ 2016, if ninety-eight
 20 percent (98%) of the uniform rate of tax used in the calculation of State
 21 Foundation Funding Aid for fiscal year ~~2015-2016~~ 2016-2017 exceeds nine
 22 hundred twenty million seven hundred thirty-one thousand eight hundred
 23 nineteen dollars (\$920,731,819), the Department of Education shall pay up to
 24 fifteen million dollars (\$15,000,000) of the total increase over the nine
 25 hundred twenty million seven hundred thirty-one thousand eight hundred
 26 nineteen dollars (\$920,731,819) to the Employee Benefits Division of the
 27 Department of Finance and Administration in additional health insurance
 28 contributions for eligible employees electing to participate in the public
 29 school employees' health insurance program administered by the State and
 30 Public School Life and Health Insurance Board.

31 The Department of Education shall make the contributions by transferring
 32 funds to the division in quarterly installments. Funds provided by the
 33 Department of Education to the division under this section shall be
 34 administered by the board for the benefit of the employee participants of the

8 to fund the appropriation authorized from general revenue for the Gifted and
9 Talented program as appropriated in Section 1 herein. With this additional
10 funding the duration of the Arkansas Governor's School shall be extended from
11 four (4) weeks to six (6) weeks.

17 FUNDING PROVISION. Of the total amount appropriated for Technology Grants
18 each fiscal year, an amount of not less than two million dollars (\$2,000,000)
19 or eighteen percent (18%), whichever is greater each fiscal year, shall be
20 awarded through a grant or professional services contract for EAST
21 infrastructure, personnel, and operating expenses. The EAST infrastructure
22 grant or contract for personal services and operating expenses shall be
23 awarded to an entity that has personnel or experience, or both, in
24 implementing the EAST Initiative.

25 The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1, ~~2015~~

28 SECTION 29. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS
29 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW.
30 INTERVENTION BLOCK GRANTS FUNDING RESTRICTION. The Department of Education
31 shall make available from the Intervention Block Grants appropriation
32 authorized by this Act, one hundred thousand dollars (\$100,000) each fiscal
33 year for the annual expenses of the Quiz Bowl, thirteen thousand five hundred
34 dollars (\$13,500) each fiscal year for Creativity in Arkansas, Inc. for
35 grants up to \$1,000 each for students and chaperones, thirteen thousand five
36 hundred dollars (\$13,500) each fiscal year for Destination Imagination, one

1 hundred thousand dollars (\$100,000) each fiscal year for the State History
 2 Day Competition, and seventy-five thousand dollars (\$75,000) each fiscal year
 3 for a grant to the Arkansas Science Fair Association for grants to regional
 4 and the state science fairs. The Department of Education shall allocate
 5 General Revenue funding totaling no less than three hundred two thousand
 6 dollars (\$302,000) each fiscal year from the Department of Education Public
 7 School Fund Account to support the annual expenses of the Quiz Bowl, the
 8 Creativity in Arkansas, Inc. for grants up to \$1,000 each for students and
 9 chaperones, Destination Imagination, the State History Day Competition, and
 10 the Arkansas Science Fair Association for grants to regional and state
 11 science fairs. The Department shall either expend or have committed for
 12 expenditure the monies allocated for the Quiz Bowl, Creativity in Arkansas,
 13 Inc., Destination Imagination, the State History Day Competition, and
 14 Arkansas Science Fair Association grants as authorized herein in order to
 15 fulfill the provisions of this section.

19 SECTION 30. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS

 21 SCHOOL DISTRICT ISOLATED - BASE FUNDING UNDER CERTAIN CIRCUMSTANCES.

22 (a) The amount of funding a school district receives under either § 6-
 23 20-604(c) and (h) or § 6-20-604(d) and (h) in the fiscal year 2014-2015 shall
 24 become the base year funding for fiscal year 2015-2016 if a school district
 25 meets the following requirements in the 2014-2015 fiscal year and all of the
 26 following requirements except for population density ratio in the 2015-2016
 27 fiscal year:

28 (1) Either:

29 (A) Sections 6-20-604(b) and (c); or

30 (B) Sections 6-20-604(b) and (d); and

31 (2) Section 6-20-601.

32 (b) If after the 2015-2016 fiscal year, an increase in a school
 33 district's population density ratio precludes funding under § 6-20-604(c) and
 34 (h) or § 6-20-604(d) and (h), the amount of funding a school district shall
 35 receive is the amount specified under subsection (a) of this section less ten
 36 percent (10%) cumulative each year until the funding amount a school district

1 receives is the amount of funding the school district is eligible to receive
2 under:

3 (1) Sections 6-20-604(e) and (h); or

4 (2) Section 6-20-604(f).

5 The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1, 2015

8 SECTION 31. COMPLIANCE WITH OTHER LAWS. Disbursement of funds
9 authorized by this act shall be limited to the appropriation for such agency
10 and funds made available by law for the support of such appropriations; and
11 the restrictions of the State Procurement Law, the General Accounting and
12 Budgetary Procedures Law, the Revenue Stabilization Law, the Regular Salary
13 Procedures and Restrictions Act, or their successors, and other fiscal
14 control laws of this State, where applicable, and regulations promulgated by
15 the Department of Finance and Administration, as authorized by law, shall be
16 strictly complied with in disbursement of said funds.

17
18 SECTION 32. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General
19 Assembly that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations
20 contained in this act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for
21 which this act was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive
22 Recommendations and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget
23 manuals prepared by the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or
24 summarized oral testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative
25 Council or Joint Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption.

26
27 SECTION 33. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the
28 General Assembly, that the Constitution of the State of Arkansas prohibits
29 the appropriation of funds for more than a one (1) year period; that the
30 effectiveness of this Act on July 1, 2016 is essential to the operation of
31 the agency for which the appropriations in this Act are provided, and that in
32 the event of an extension of the legislative session, the delay in the
33 effective date of this Act beyond July 1, 2016 could work irreparable harm
34 upon the proper administration and provision of essential governmental
35 programs. Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act
36 being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health

and safety shall be in full force and effect from and after July 1, 2016.

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
