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26	WHEREAS, under Arkansas law the General Assembly created multicounty
27	planning and development organizations, known as "planning and development
28	districts", to:
29	(1) Promote economic development;
30	(2) Assist local governments and private organizations in obtaining
31	federal grants and loans;
32	(3) Prepare comprehensive regional plans for economic development and
33	<pre>improved government services;</pre>
34 25	(4) Enlist private support for these activities; and
35	(5) Coordinate private and public programs in the planning and
36	development districts; and



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2 WHEREAS, in order to encourage the planning and development districts 3 in their efforts to provide these beneficial services, the General Assembly 4 established a program of providing financial assistance to the planning and 5 development districts to enable them to continue and expand their activities 6 in furtherance of these services; and

8 WHEREAS, there are currently eight (8) planning and development 9 districts operating in Arkansas,

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11 NOW THEREFORE,

12 BE IT PROPOSED BY THE SENATE OF THE NINETIETH GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE 13 OF ARKANSAS:

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15 THAT the Senate Committee on City, County, and Local Affairs is 16 encouraged to conduct a study of the best practices of planning and 17 development districts that may be implemented to improve the efficiency of 18 the planning and development districts; review the economic development tools 19 of the planning and development districts to determine if the planning and 20 development districts are acting in furtherance of the purposes stated in the 21 law; determine the feasibility of consolidation of planning and development 22 districts to promote economic development; conduct the study with the 23 assistance of the planning and development districts; and report to the 24 Senate Committee on City, County, and Local Affairs and the House Committee 25 on City, County, and Local Affairs with findings and recommendations from the 26 study by December 1, 2016.

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
