14	(c) This section shall expire on June 30, 2017.		
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16	SECTION 2. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the		
17	General Assembly of the State of Arkansas that federal law requires a change		
18	in state accountability systems for public schools and school districts; that		
19	the Department of Education must use the 2016-2017 school year to develop a		
20	new accountability system in order to comply with federal law; and that this		
21	act is immediately necessary to facilitate the transition to a new		
22	accountability system. Therefore, an emergency is declared to exist, and		
23	this act being immediately necessary for the preservation of the public		
24	peace, health, and safety shall become effective on:		
25	(1) The date of its approval by the Governor;		
26	(2) If the bill is neither approved nor vetoed by the Governor,		
27	the expiration of the period of time during which the Governor may veto the		
28	bill; or		
29	(3) If the bill is vetoed by the Governor and the veto is		
30	overridden, the date the last house overrides the veto.		
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
