26	SECTION 1. TEMPORARY L	ANGUAGE. DO NOT CODIFY. The	Chief Fiscal Officer

34	SECTION 2. TEMPORARY	LANGUAGE. DO NOT CODIFY. Be	efore crediting the
35	interest income earnings as required under Arkansas Code § 19-5-501(a)(2),		
36	the Treasurer of State shall make a one-time transfer of one million five		

1 hundred thousand dollars (\$1,500,000) to the State Highway and Transportation 2 Department Fund, to be transferred only in fiscal year 2017. 3 4 SECTION 3. TEMPORARY LANGUAGE. DO NOT CODIFY. For fiscal year 2017, 5 the sales and use taxes levied under Arkansas Constitution, Amendment 91, § 6 3, are not subject to deduction, transfer, or distribution to the 7 Constitutional Officers Fund or the State Central Services Fund under 8 Arkansas Code §§ 19-5-202, 19-5-203, and 19-5-205. 9 10 SECTION 4. TEMPORARY LANGUAGE. DO NOT CODIFY. (a) Every other month, the Arkansas State Highway and Transportation Department shall report the 11 12 department's activities to the joint meetings of the Senate Committee on 13 Public Transportation, Technology, and Legislative Affairs and the House 14 Committee on Public Transportation. 15 (b) The Senate Committee on Public Transportation, Technology, and 16 Legislative Affairs and the House Committee on Public Transportation shall 17 meet every other month when the General Assembly is not in session to review 18 the activities of the department. 19 (c) This section expires June 30, 2017. 20 21 SECTION 5. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the General 22 Assembly of the State of Arkansas that Arkansas highways, roads, and bridges 23 are in need of repair and proper maintenance; that the repair and proper maintenance of Arkansas highways, roads, and bridges are necessary for the 24 25 preservation of the public peace, health, and safety; that increased funding is essential to the immediate repair and proper maintenance of Arkansas 26 27 highways, roads, and bridges; that it is essential that this act be given effect on July 1, 2016, to coincide with the beginning of a new fiscal year; 28 29 that under the Constitution of Arkansas, acts without an emergency clause do not take effect until ninety (90) days after sine die adjournment of the 30 General Assembly; that unless an emergency is declared, extension of the 2016 31 Third Extraordinary Session of the General Assembly will result in a delay in 32 the effective date of this act beyond July 1 and would work irreparable harm; 33 34 and this act is necessary because without the increased funding provided by 35 this act, the repair and proper maintenance of Arkansas highways, roads, and 36 bridges may not be performed. Therefore, an emergency is declared to exist,

1	and this act being necessary for the preservation of the public peace,
2	health, and safety shall become effective on July 1, 2016.
