20	BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:
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22	SECTION 1. Arkansas Code Title 6, Chapter 51, is amended to add an
23	additional subchapter to read as follows:

25	Subchapter 11
26	Transfer of Crowley's Ridge Technical Institute
27	to East Arkansas Community College
28	
29	6-51-1101. Merger.
30	(a) On July 1, 2016, Crowley's Ridge Technical Institute is merged
31	with and into East Arkansas Community College.
32	(b) Except as provided in this subchapter, on July 1, 2016, all
33	statutory authority, powers, duties, functions, records, personnel, property,
34	unexpended balances of appropriations, allocations, or other funds, including
35	the functions of budgeting or purchasing, of Crowley's Ridge Technical
36	Institute are transferred to East Arkansas Community College.

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2	6-51-1102. Board of directors and ex officio board of trustees.
3	On the effective date of this act, the Board of Directors of Crowley's
4	Ridge Technical Institute is abolished, and the Board of Directors of East
5	Arkansas Community College shall assume the powers and duties of the Board of
6	Directors of Crowley's Ridge Technical Institute.
7	
8	6-51-1103. Purchasing.
9	(a) On and after July 1, 2016, purchases by East Arkansas Community
10	College may continue to be made under procedures that were applicable to East
11	Arkansas Community College or may be made under procedures that were
12	applicable to Crowley's Ridge Technical Institute.
13	(b) On and after July 1, 2016, flexibility in shop purchases, parts,
14	and house construction programs shall continue in the same manner authorized
15	for the original institutions.
16	
17	6-51-1104. Transfer of assets, obligations, records, personnel,
18	property, unexpended balances, and legal authority.
19	(a) On July 1, 2016, all property and other rights, claims, and assets
20	of Crowley's Ridge Technical Institute are transferred to East Arkansas
21	Community College.
22	(b) On July 1, 2016, all obligations of Crowley's Ridge Technical
23	Institute are obligations of East Arkansas Community College.
24	(c)(1) Except as provided in subdivision (c)(2) of this section, on
25	July 1, 2016, all records, personnel, property, unexpended balances, and
26	legal authority are transferred from Crowley's Ridge Technical Institute to
27	East Arkansas Community College.
28	(2) The personnel transferred from Crowley's Ridge Technical
29	Institute to East Arkansas Community College shall comply with Section 3 of
30	this act.
31	(d) On and after July 1, 2016, all cash fund balances of Crowley's
32	Ridge Technical Institute transferred to East Arkansas Community College
33	shall be used for the operation, support, and improvement of occupational,
34	vocational, technical, and workforce development programs of East Arkansas
35	Community College.

1	6-51-1105. Funding from the Work Force 2000 Development Fund.
2	On and after July 1, 2016, funding from the Work Force 2000 Development
3	Fund, which would have been provided to Crowley's Ridge Technical Institute,
4	shall be provided to East Arkansas Community College to fund workforce
5	development, vocational, occupational, and training programs offered by East
6	Arkansas Community College.
7	
8	6-51-1106. Funding from the Federal Adult Basic Education Fund.
9	On and after July 1, 2016, funding from the Federal Adult Basic
10	Education Fund, which would have been provided to Crowley's Ridge Technical
11	Institute, shall be provided to East Arkansas Community College.
12	
13	SECTION 2. <u>DO NOT CODIFY.</u>
14	(a) The General Assembly finds that:
15	(1) Significant changes in the day-to-day operations of
16	Crowley's Ridge Technical Institute before July 1, 2016, may impede the
17	ability of the institution to merge seamlessly into East Arkansas Community
18	College; and
19	(2) Additional guidance and restrictions are necessary to assure
20	a smooth transition to the new institutional structure of East Arkansas
21	Community College created by this act.
22	(b) Except as provided in subsection (c) of this section, on and after
23	the effective date of this act and before July 1, 2016, Crowley's Ridge
24	Technical Institute shall not:
25	(1) Change its policies or procedures;
26	(2) Terminate an employee of Crowley's Ridge Technical
27	<pre>Institute;</pre>
28	(3) Transfer an employee of Crowley's Ridge Technical Institute
29	to a different position;
30	(4) Hire a new employee of Crowley's Ridge Technical Institute;
31	<u>or</u>
32	(5) Destroy, mutilate, or alter documents, records, or other
33	property maintained by Crowley's Ridge Technical Institute or its employees
34	unless the alteration is made in the normal course of business and the nature
35	of and reason for the alteration are recorded.
36	(c) If Crowley's Ridge Technical Institute determines that performance

- l of one (1) or more of the actions prohibited in subsection (b) of this
- 2 section are necessary to appropriately perform the duties or functions of
- 3 Crowley's Ridge Technical Institute:
- 4 (1) The Technical Institute Director or the Interim Technical
- 5 <u>Institute Director of Crowley's Ridge Technical Institute may request that</u>
- 6 the Board of Directors of East Arkansas Community College permit performance
- 7 of the action; and
- 8 (2) The Board of Directors of East Arkansas Community College
- 9 may grant or deny permission to perform the requested action.
- 10 (d) On and after the effective date of this act and before July 1,
- 11 2016, Crowley's Ridge Technical Institute shall provide to the President of
- 12 East Arkansas Community College or his or her designee any document, record,
- 13 testimony, explanation, or other information maintained by Crowley's Ridge
- 14 Technical Institute or its employees upon the request of the President of
- 15 <u>East Arkansas Community College or his or her designee.</u>

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- 17 SECTION 3. Section 1 of Uncodified Act 155 of the Fiscal Session of 2016 is amended to read as follows:

16	merger; and that this act is immediately necessar	cy to allow	w a smooth
17	transition at the beginning of the fiscal year.	Therefore	, an emergency is

21	(1) The date of its approval by the	Governor;
