1	(a)(1) A school district shall require a student being transported in	
2	a school bus operated by or contracted for operation by the school district	
3	to wear a seat belt or passenger restraint system if the school bus is	
4	required under § 6-19-117(g) to be equipped with a seat belt or passenger	
5	restraint system for each passenger on the school bus.	
6	(2) Except as provided in subsection (c) of this section, a	
7	student being transported in a school bus that is required to be equipped	
8	with seat belts or passenger restraint systems shall use a seat belt or	
9	passenger restraint system at all times while the school bus is in motion.	
10	(b) A school district may implement a disciplinary policy to enforce	
11	the use of seat belts and passenger restraint systems by students being	
12	transported in a school bus.	
13	(c) This section does not apply:	
14	(1)(A) To a passenger with a physically disabling condition or	
15	medical condition that prevents appropriate restraint in a seat belt or a	
16	passenger restraint system, if the condition is certified in writing by a	
17	licensed physician or licensed chiropractor.	
18	(B) The licensed physician or licensed chiropractor	
19	providing the certification under subdivision (c)(l)(A) of this section shall	
20	state the nature of the condition and the reason the seat belt or passenger	
21	restraint system is inappropriate; or	
22	(2)(A) In the case of an emergency that may necessitate the	
23	loading of school children on a school bus in excess of the limits of its	
24	seating capacity.	
25	(B) As used in this subdivision (c)(2), "emergency" means	
26	a natural disaster or hazard that requires students to be moved immediately	
27	in order to ensure their safety.	
28	(d) If a petition signed by at least ten percent (10%) of a school	
29	district's qualified electors is submitted to the school district requesting	
30	that the school district's school buses be equipped with seat belts or	
31	passenger restraint systems, the school district shall:	
32	(1) Propose to levy an additional annual ad valorem property tax	
33	on the assessed value of taxable real, personal, or utility property as	
34	authorized by Arkansas Constitution, Article 14, § 3(c)(1) for the cost of:	
35	(A) Purchasing, installing, and maintaining the seat belts	
36	or passenger restraint systems required under § 6-19-117(g); and	

1	(b) Developing and making available to each school
2	district a program of instruction in the proper use of a school bus seat belt
3	or passenger restraint system;
4	(2) Calculate the amount of the additional tax levied to be
5	included in the school district's proposal required by subdivision (d)(1) of
6	this section; and
7	(3) Place the proposal required by subdivision (d)(1) of this
8	section on the ballot to be voted on by qualified electors at the annual
9	school election held as provided in § 6-14-102(a)(1).
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
