9	(B) The reports required by this section shall be filed in		
10	electronic form through the official website of the Secretary of State.		
11	(C) The Arkansas Ethics Commission shall approve the		
12	format used by the Secretary of State for the filing of exploratory reports		
13	in electronic form to ensure that all required information is requested.		
14	(D) The official website of the Secretary of State shall		
15	allow for searches of exploratory committee report information filed in		
16	electronic form.		
17	(2) The committee shall not accept contributions after the		
18	filing of a final report.

20	SECTION 4. Arkansas Code § 7-6-220(e), concerning reporting of		
21	independent expenditures and resulting from Initiated Act 1 of 1996, is

24	mailed to the Secretary of State, properly addressed, postage prepaid,		
25	bearing a postmark indicating that it was received by the post office or		
26	common carrier filed in electronic form through the official website of the		
27	Secretary of State on or before the date that the report is due.		
28	(2) The Secretary of State shall accept via facsimile any		
29	report if the original is received by the Secretary of State within ten (10)		
30	days of the date of transmission.		
31	$\frac{(3)(2)(A)}{(2)(A)}$ The Secretary of State $\frac{may}{(2)(A)}$ receive reports
