18 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

20 SECTION 1. Arkansas Code § 6-1-404(a), concerning the membership of  
21 the School Leadership Coordinating Council, is amended to read as follows:

22 (a) The School Leadership Coordinating Council consists of ~~thirteen~~  
23 ~~(13)~~ fifteen (15) members as follows:

24 (1) The Chair of the Arkansas Association of Colleges for  
25 Teacher Education Council of Deans;

26 (2) The Commissioner of Education;

27 (3) The Director of the Arkansas Leadership Academy;

29 (5) The Director of the Department of Career Education;

31 Educational Administrators;

32 (7) The Executive Director of the Arkansas Education

35 Association;

36 (9) The Executive Director of the Arkansas Association for

2 (10) The President of the Arkansas Rural Education Association;

3 (11) A representative from the Arkansas Professors of

5 (12) A representative from the Arkansas Center for Executive

7 (13) A representative from an education service cooperative;

8 (14) The Chair of the Senate Committee on Education or the

9 chair's designee; and

10 (15) The Chair of the House Committee on Education or the

11 chair's designee.

 13 SECTION 2. Arkansas Code § 6-1-404(f), concerning expenses incurred  
 14 from serving on the School Leadership Coordinating Council, is amended to  
 15 read as follows:

16 (f)(1) All nonlegislative members of the council may receive expense  
 17 reimbursement in accordance with § 25-16-902 paid by the Department of  
 18 Education if funds are available.

19 (2) Legislative members of the council shall be paid per diem  
 20 and mileage as authorized by law for attendance at meetings of interim  
 21 committees of the General Assembly.
