1 (A) A certified law enforcement officer pursuant to a 2 criminal investigation but only after the law enforcement officer obtains a 3 search warrant signed by a judge that demonstrates probable cause to believe 4 that a violation of federal or state criminal law has occurred, that 5 specified information contained in the database would assist in the 6 investigation of the crime, and that the specified information should be 7 released to the certified law enforcement officer; 8 (B) A regulatory body engaged in the supervision of 9 activities of licensing or regulatory boards of practitioners authorized to 10 prescribe or dispense controlled substances; 11 (C) A person or entity investigating a case involving 12 breaches of privacy involving the database or its records; 13 (D) A certified law enforcement prescription drug 14 diversion investigator of a qualified law enforcement agency; or 15 (E) The Arkansas Medicaid prescription drug program; or 16 (E)(F) The Department of Human Services or the Crimes 17 Against Children Division of the Department of Arkansas State Police if: 18 (i) The purpose of the database access is related to 19 an investigation under the Child Maltreatment Act, § 12-18-101 et seq., and 20 not pursuant to a criminal investigation by a certified law enforcement 21 officer; and 22 (ii) The Department of Human Services has obtained a 23 circuit court order to access the database under § 12-18-622. 24 25 /s/Boyd 26 27 28 29 30 31 32 33 34 35 36
