19	SECTION 2. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the		
20	General Assembly of the State of Arkansas that thousands of citizens of		
21	Arkansas are on a waiting list to receive home and community-based services		
22	that they need to maintain quality of life; that the present Alternative		
23	Community Services Waiver Program, also known as the "Developmental		
24	Disabilities Waiver", does not have the capacity to provide assistance to		
25	these individuals; and that this act is immediately necessary to ensure the		
26	health and safety of the individuals with intellectual and developmental		
27	disabilities in the State of Arkansas. Therefore, an emergency is declared to		
28	exist, and this act being immediately necessary for the preservation of the		
29	public peace, health, and safety shall become effective on:		
30	(1) The date of its approval by the Governor;		
31	(2) If the bill is neither approved nor vetoed by the Governor,		
32	the expiration of the period of time during which the Governor may veto the		
33	bill; or		
34	(3) If the bill is vetoed by the Governor and the veto is		
35	overridden, the date the last house overrides the veto.		

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
