33	not make the certification under subdivision (c)(1) of this section shall not		
34	be eligible to accept state aid from the Higher Education Grants Fund Account

1	supported institution of higher education shall provide each law enforcement
2	officer and campus security officer employed by or contracted with the state-
3	supported institution of higher education a printed copy of this section with
4	written notice of his or her duty to cooperate with state and federal
5	agencies and officials on matters of enforcement of state and federal laws
6	governing immigration.
