ADDITIONAL SALARY/COMPENSATION PROVISION. No employee drawing a salary or

other form of compensation from the Arkansas Schools for the Deaf or Blind

22 shall be paid an additional salary or receive additional compensation, other

23 than reimbursement for actual expenses, from that agency, nor from any other

agency or institution of higher education, except from the Superintendent's written certification to and approval by the Chief Fiscal Officer of the

26 State that the work performed by the employee for the other position does not

27 interfere with the proper and required performance of the employee's primary

28 duties, and that the combined salary payments from both positions will not

29 exceed the maximum annual salary for whichever of the two positions has the

30 higher authorized maximum annual salary.

Any employee knowingly violating the provisions of this section shall be subject to immediate termination and shall be barred from employment by any agency or institution of the State of Arkansas for a period of not less than three (3) years or until such employee shall repay to the State of Arkansas any sums received by such employee in violation of this section, together

SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS 12 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. CERTIFIED MASTERS OR BACHELOR TEACHERS ENTERING STATE SERVICE. In the event that an act is enacted in which the public 9 schools receive funds from the General Assembly to raise the salaries of 10 teachers employed in the public school districts, the Arkansas School for the 11 Deaf and the Arkansas School for the Blind shall be included. 12 The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1, 2016 13 2017 through June 30, 2017 2018. 14 15 SECTION 13. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS 16 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. 17 RATES OF PAY. Due to the need to meet the minimum compensation schedule as 18 established by Act 74 of the 2nd Extraordinary Session of the 84th General 19 Assembly, or its successor, for public school teachers, counselors, and 20 librarians and other education professionals as listed in subsection (a) 21 below, the Arkansas School for the Deaf is authorized to adjust current or 22 new employees to at least the minimum level of compensation for public school 23 employees. 24 For current or new employees in the positions listed in subsection (a) 25 below, the Arkansas School for the Deaf may implement salary adjustments to 26 maintain equity between their teacher salaries and those of Central Arkansas 27 Public School Systems only after a plan for determining and implementing 28 those adjustments has been reviewed by the Office of Personnel Management and 29 by the Personnel Committee of the Arkansas Legislative Council and approved by the Chief Fiscal Officer of the State. 30
- For purposes of implementing the plan, the Arkansas School for the Deaf is authorized special rates of pay up to the maximum of the assigned grade for classifications listed in subsection (a) below.

Funding for the minimum compensation provided for in this section that is supported in whole or in part from general revenues, shall, if required, be provided by a transfer from the Merit Adjustment Fund to the proper fund or fund account and in such amounts as determined by the Chief Fiscal Officer of the State. The Arkansas School for the Deaf shall, in addition to the funds provided in this Act for Annual Career Service Recognition Payments from the Merit Adjustment Fund, make available any funding generated from agency salary savings for such purposes from the funds or fund accounts as provided by law.

The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1, $\frac{2016}{2017}$ through June 30, $\frac{2017}{2018}$.

SECTION 14. COMPLIANCE WITH OTHER LAWS. Disbursement of funds authorized by this act shall be limited to the appropriation for such agency and funds made available by law for the support of such appropriations; and the restrictions of the State Procurement Law, the General Accounting and Budgetary Procedures Law, the Revenue Stabilization Law, the Regular Salary Procedures and Restrictions Act, or their successors, and other fiscal control laws of this State, where applicable, and regulations promulgated by the Department of Finance and Administration, as authorized by law, shall be strictly complied with in disbursement of said funds.

Assembly that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations contained in this act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for which this act was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive Recommendations and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget manuals prepared by the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or summarized oral testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative

1	Council or Joint Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption.
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3	SECTION 16. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the
4	General Assembly, that the Constitution of the State of Arkansas prohibits
5	the appropriation of funds for more than a one (1) year period; that the
6	effectiveness of this Act on July 1, 2017 is essential to the operation of
7	the agency for which the appropriations in this Act are provided, and that in
8	the event of an extension of the legislative session, the delay in the
9	effective date of this Act beyond July 1, 2017 could work irreparable harm
10	upon the proper administration and provision of essential governmental
11	programs. Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act
12	being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health
13	and safety shall be in full force and effect from and after July 1, 2017.
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
