11 2018; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

14 AN ACT FOR THE STATE BOARD OF PRIVATE
15 CAREER EDUCATION APPROPRIATION FOR THE
16 2017-2018 FISCAL YEAR.
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20 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:
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22 SECTION 1. REGULAR SALARIES - OPERATIONS. There is hereby established
23 for the State Board of Private Career Education for the 2017-2018 fiscal
24 year, the following maximum number of regular employees.

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35 SECTION 2. EXTRA HELP - OPERATIONS. There is hereby authorized, for
36 the State Board of Private Career Education for the 2017-2018 fiscal year,



1 the following maximum number of part-time or temporary employees, to be known
 2 as "Extra Help", payable from funds appropriated herein for such purposes:
 3 two (2) temporary or part-time employees, when needed, at rates of pay not to
 4 exceed those provided in the Uniform Classification and Compensation Act, or
 5 its successor, or this act for the appropriate classification.

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 7 SECTION 3. APPROPRIATION - OPERATIONS. There is hereby appropriated,
 8 to the State Board of Private Career Education, to be payable from the
 9 Private Career Education Fund, for personal services and operating expenses
 10 of the State Board of Private Career Education for the fiscal year ending
 11 June 30, 2018, the following:

 30 Education for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2018, the following:

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 6 SECTION 5. APPROPRIATION - STUDENT PROTECTION TRUST. There is hereby
 7 appropriated, to the State Board of Private Career Education, to be payable
 8 from the Private Career School Student Protection Trust Fund, for expenses,
 9 claims and fees of the State Board of Private Career Education for the fiscal
 10 year ending June 30, 2018, the following:

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 16 SECTION 6. COMPLIANCE WITH OTHER LAWS. Disbursement of funds
 17 authorized by this act shall be limited to the appropriation for such agency
 18 and funds made available by law for the support of such appropriations; and
 19 the restrictions of the State Procurement Law, the General Accounting and
 20 Budgetary Procedures Law, the Revenue Stabilization Law, the Regular Salary
 21 Procedures and Restrictions Act, or their successors, and other fiscal
 22 control laws of this State, where applicable, and regulations promulgated by
 23 the Department of Finance and Administration, as authorized by law, shall be
 24 strictly complied with in disbursement of said funds.

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 26 SECTION 7. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General
 27 Assembly that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations
 28 contained in this act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for
 29 which this act was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive
 30 Recommendations and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget
 31 manuals prepared by the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or
 32 summarized oral testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative
 33 Council or Joint Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption.

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 35 SECTION 8. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the General
 36 Assembly, that the Constitution of the State of Arkansas prohibits the

1 appropriation of funds for more than a one (1) year period; that the
2 effectiveness of this Act on July 1, 2017 is essential to the operation of
3 the agency for which the appropriations in this Act are provided, and that in
4 the event of an extension of the legislative session, the delay in the
5 effective date of this Act beyond July 1, 2017 could work irreparable harm
6 upon the proper administration and provision of essential governmental
7 programs. Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act
8 being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health
9 and safety shall be in full force and effect from and after July 1, 2017.

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
