9	(c) When a petition is filed with a court of competent jurisdiction to	
10	change the cause or manner of death listed on a <del>death</del> certificate <u>of death</u>	
11	hich has been signed by the examiner or by his or her designee, the State	
12	Crime Laboratory shall be notified of such petition, and the examiner or his	
13	or her designee shall be allowed to hear testimony presented by the	
14	petitioner and shall be given an opportunity to present evidence to the court	
15	to support the original ruling of the examiner or his or her <del>assistant</del>	
16	designee who signed the certificate of death.	
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
