21	SECTION 3. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS			
22	CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. TRANSFER			
23	PROVISION. If the State Treasurer should determine that the appropriations			
24	made available for payments of maturing bonds and interest for the College			
25	Savings General Obligation Bonds, the Higher Education General Obligation			
26	Bonds, the State Waste Disposal and Pollution Abatement Facilities General			
27	Obligation Bonds, and the State Water Resources Development General			
28	Obligation Bonds are insufficient, appropriation may be transferred from the			
29	Refunds/Reimbursement line item to the Debt Service line item for payment of			
30	said bonds.			
31	The provisions of this section shall be in effect only f	rom July 1, <del>2016</del>		
32	<u>2017</u> through June 30, <del>2017</del> <u>2018</u> .

34	SECTION 4. COMPLIANCE WITH OTHER LAWS. Disbursement of funds			
35	authorized by this act shall be limited to the appropriation for such agency			
36	and funds made available by law for the support of such appropriations; and

the restrictions of the State Procurement Law, the General Accounting and
Budgetary Procedures Law, the Revenue Stabilization Law, the Regular Salary
Procedures and Restrictions Act, or their successors, and other fiscal
control laws of this State, where applicable, and regulations promulgated by
the Department of Finance and Administration, as authorized by law, shall be
strictly complied with in disbursement of said funds.

8 SECTION 5. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General 9 Assembly that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations 10 contained in this act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for 11 which this act was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive 12 Recommendations and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget 13 manuals prepared by the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or 14 summarized oral testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative 15 Council or Joint Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption. 16

17 SECTION 6. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the General 18 Assembly, that the Constitution of the State of Arkansas prohibits the 19 appropriation of funds for more than a one (1) year period; that the 20 effectiveness of this Act on July 1, 2017 is essential to the operation of 21 the agency for which the appropriations in this Act are provided, and that in 22 the event of an extension of the legislative session, the delay in the 23 effective date of this Act beyond July 1, 2017 could work irreparable harm 24 upon the proper administration and provision of essential governmental 25 programs. Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act 26 being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety shall be in full force and effect from and after July 1, 2017. 27 28 29 30 31 32 33 34 35
