7 SECTION 20. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS 8 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. MATCHING 9 FUNDS. The funds appropriated in this Act for Department of Justice Non-10 Victim Assistance Matching Grants shall be used for matching funds for 11 administering the Federal Grants provided in this Act for the Department of 12 Justice Non-Victim Assistance Grants. The Department of Finance and 13 Administration - Management Services Division is hereby authorized to call 14 upon all state agencies to assist in the implementation of the Department of 15 Justice Non-Victim Assistance Grants. The funds appropriated in this Act for 16 Department of Justice Non-Victim Assistance Matching Grants shall be used to 17 provide one hundred percent (100%) of the required matching funds for state 18 agencies and to provide up to sixty percent (60%) of the required matching 19 funds for local governments. 35 SECTION 21. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS
36 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. SELECTION

OF AUDITOR. The Legislative Auditor and Chief Fiscal Officer of the State
shall jointly select the independent auditor to audit the Comprehensive
Annual Financial Report for the period ending June 30, 2017 2018.
The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1, 2016
2017 through June 30, 2017 2018.

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SECTION 22. COMPLIANCE WITH OTHER LAWS. Disbursement of funds 7 8 authorized by this act shall be limited to the appropriation for such agency and funds made available by law for the support of such appropriations; and 9 10 the restrictions of the State Procurement Law, the General Accounting and 11 Budgetary Procedures Law, the Revenue Stabilization Law, the Regular Salary 12 Procedures and Restrictions Act, or their successors, and other fiscal 13 control laws of this State, where applicable, and regulations promulgated by 14 the Department of Finance and Administration, as authorized by law, shall be 15 strictly complied with in disbursement of said funds.

17 SECTION 23. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General 18 Assembly that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations 19 contained in this act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for 20 which this act was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive 21 Recommendations and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget 22 manuals prepared by the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or 23 summarized oral testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative 24 Council or Joint Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption. 25

26 SECTION 24. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the 27 General Assembly, that the Constitution of the State of Arkansas prohibits 28 the appropriation of funds for more than a one (1) year period; that the effectiveness of this Act on July 1, 2017 is essential to the operation of 29 30 the agency for which the appropriations in this Act are provided, and that in the event of an extension of the legislative session, the delay in the 31 32 effective date of this Act beyond July 1, 2017 could work irreparable harm 33 upon the proper administration and provision of essential governmental 34 programs. Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act 35 being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health 36 and safety shall be in full force and effect from and after July 1, 2017.

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
