7 SECTION 20. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS 8 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. MATCHING 9 FUNDS. The funds appropriated in this Act for Department of Justice Non-10 Victim Assistance Matching Grants shall be used for matching funds for 11 administering the Federal Grants provided in this Act for the Department of 12 Justice Non-Victim Assistance Grants. The Department of Finance and 13 Administration - Management Services Division is hereby authorized to call 14 upon all state agencies to assist in the implementation of the Department of 15 Justice Non-Victim Assistance Grants. The funds appropriated in this Act for 16 Department of Justice Non-Victim Assistance Matching Grants shall be used to 17 provide one hundred percent (100%) of the required matching funds for state 18 agencies and to provide up to sixty percent (60%) of the required matching 19 funds for local governments. Such funds and appropriation shall be 20 transferred to eligible state agencies or paid to local governments to be 21 used for matching federal funds for administration of the Department of 22 Justice Non-Victim Assistance Grants in such amounts as determined by the 23 Arkansas Alcohol and Drug Abuse Coordinating Council or other oversight 24 agency as designated by the Governor. Any unobligated balances in funds in 25 this Act for the Department of Justice Non-Victim Assistance Grants may be 26 used by state agencies as matching funds for other U.S. Department of Justice 27 Grants in an amount determined by the Chief Fiscal Officer of the State. 28 Any unexpended balances in funds provided for Department of Justice Non-29 Victim Assistance Matching Grants in this act remaining on June 30, 2016 30 2017, may be carried forward and used for the same purpose during the fiscal 31 year ending June 30, 2017 2018. 32 The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1, 2016 33 2017 through June 30, 2017 2018.

35 SECTION 21. COMPLIANCE WITH OTHER LAWS. Disbursement of funds 36 authorized by this act shall be limited to the appropriation for such agency

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and funds made available by law for the support of such appropriations; and the restrictions of the State Procurement Law, the General Accounting and Budgetary Procedures Law, the Revenue Stabilization Law, the Regular Salary Procedures and Restrictions Act, or their successors, and other fiscal control laws of this State, where applicable, and regulations promulgated by the Department of Finance and Administration, as authorized by law, shall be strictly complied with in disbursement of said funds.

9 SECTION 22. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General 10 Assembly that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations 11 contained in this act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for which this act was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive 12 13 Recommendations and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget 14 manuals prepared by the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or 15 summarized oral testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative 16 Council or Joint Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption. 17

18 SECTION 23. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the 19 General Assembly, that the Constitution of the State of Arkansas prohibits 20 the appropriation of funds for more than a one (1) year period; that the effectiveness of this Act on July 1, 2017 is essential to the operation of 21 22 the agency for which the appropriations in this Act are provided, and that in 23 the event of an extension of the legislative session, the delay in the effective date of this Act beyond July 1, 2017 could work irreparable harm 24 25 upon the proper administration and provision of essential governmental 26 programs. Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act 27 being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety shall be in full force and effect from and after July 1, 2017. 28 29 30 /s/Joint Budget Committee 31 32

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
