28 SECTION 66. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS  
29 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. WORK  
30 FORCE 2000 DISTRIBUTION. After the amounts to be made available to the  
31 various technical institutes or comprehensive lifelong learning centers have  
32 been determined as set out in Arkansas Code 26-51-205(d)(2)(A) and 26-51-  
33 205(d)(2)(B), such documents as may be necessary shall be processed so that  
34 funds may be transferred from the Work Force 2000 Development Fund to the  
35 State Treasury fund or fund account from which the technical institute or  
36 comprehensive lifelong learning center draws its general revenue support.

1 Such funds as may be transferred shall not exceed 6.309% of the total funds  
2 available from the Work Force 2000 Development Fund during each fiscal year.

3 In the event that a technical college, community college or educational  
4 institution which receives support from the Work Force 2000 Development Fund  
5 as determined by law transfers from the Arkansas Technical College and  
6 Community College System for which Work Force 2000 Development Fund monies  
7 are determined by law, then the actual amount of support from the Work Force  
8 2000 Development Fund in the preceding fiscal year for such educational  
9 institution shall be made available irrespective of any other provision of  
10 law which sets out maximum levels of support from such fund.

11 The funds distributed under Arkansas Code 26-51-205(d)(2)(C) in excess of  
12 those amounts collected and distributed prior to June 30, 2014 shall be  
13 deposited into the Skills Development Fund to be used only for personal  
14 services, grants, operation, support, and improvement of occupational,  
15 vocational, technical, and workforce development programs by the Department  
16 of Career Education - Office of Skills Development. The distributions of  
17 funds under Arkansas Code 26-51-205(d)(2)(C) in excess of those amounts  
18 collected and distributed prior to June 30, 2014 shall not apply to proceeds  
19 allocated to schools, colleges and educational institutions under Arkansas  
20 Code 26-51-205(d)(2)(A) and 26-51-205(d)(2)(B).

21 The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1, ~~2016~~

24 SECTION 67. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS  
25 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. TRANSFER  
26 PROCEDURES - PERSONAL SERVICES EXTRA HELP. In the event that there is not  
27 sufficient appropriation provided for by the General Assembly for payment of  
28 personal services related to Extra Help for any state agency for the period  
29 ending June 30, ~~2017~~ 2018, said agency may request a transfer from  
30 appropriations provided for personal services Extra Help in the Miscellaneous  
31 Transfers Section herein, from the Chief Fiscal Officer of the State, stating  
32 clearly the amount required. Upon approval of the Chief Fiscal Officer of  
33 the State, and after seeking prior review by the Arkansas Legislative Council  
34 or Joint Budget Committee, the State Auditor shall be notified as to the  
35 amount and the purposes for which said appropriation is to be made. The  
36 appropriation shall then be established upon the books of the Department of



1 Finance and Administration and the State Auditor. Provided further, that if  
2 desired, said appropriation shall be supplemental to those regularly  
3 appropriated for such purposes by the General Assembly for the agency.

7 SECTION 68. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS  
8 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW.

9 INTRASTATE METRO PLANNING GRANTS. As referenced in Section 9 of Act 637 of  
10 1995, the authorized funding for Intrastate Metro Planning Grants that are  
11 evenly distributed among planning and development districts under the  
12 Miscellaneous Grants and Expenses Section of this Act shall include the West  
13 Central Arkansas Economic Development District.

14 The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1,  
15 ~~2016~~2017 through June 30, ~~2017~~2018.

16  
17 SECTION 69. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS  
18 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. FUND  
19 USAGE AUTHORIZED. The Arkansas Children's Hospital President and C.E.O. may  
20 request the Department of Human Services-Division of Medical Services to  
21 retain in the Department of Human Services Grant Fund account an amount not  
22 to exceed \$1,000,000 for funds made available by the act to be used to match  
23 federal funds used for supplemental Medicaid payments to Arkansas Children's  
24 Hospital.

25 The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1, ~~2016~~  
26 2017 through June 30, ~~2017~~ 2018.

27  
28 SECTION 70. COMPLIANCE WITH OTHER LAWS. Disbursement of funds  
29 authorized by this act shall be limited to the appropriation for such agency  
30 and funds made available by law for the support of such appropriations; and  
31 the restrictions of the State Procurement Law, the General Accounting and  
32 Budgetary Procedures Law, the Revenue Stabilization Law, the Regular Salary  
33 Procedures and Restrictions Act, or their successors, and other fiscal  
34 control laws of this State, where applicable, and regulations promulgated by  
35 the Department of Finance and Administration, as authorized by law, shall be  
36 strictly complied with in disbursement of said funds.

1  
2 SECTION 71. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General  
3 Assembly that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations  
4 contained in this act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for  
5 which this act was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive  
6 Recommendations and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget  
7 manuals prepared by the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or  
8 summarized oral testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative  
9 Council or Joint Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption.  
10

11 SECTION 72. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the  
12 General Assembly, that the Constitution of the State of Arkansas prohibits  
13 the appropriation of funds for more than a one (1) year period; that the  
14 effectiveness of this Act on July 1, 2017 is essential to the operation of  
15 the agency for which the appropriations in this Act are provided, and that in  
16 the event of an extension of the legislative session, the delay in the  
17 effective date of this Act beyond July 1, 2017 could work irreparable harm  
18 upon the proper administration and provision of essential governmental  
19 programs. Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act  
20 being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health  
21 and safety shall be in full force and effect from and after July 1, 2017.  
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
