1	Board of Trustees of the Arkansas Public Employees' Retirement System, is

3	(2)(A) If any state employee trustee leaves the employ of the		
4	state or if any nonstate employee trustee leaves the employ of a		
5	participating public employer, the board shall, by a majority of the		
6	membership of the board, fill the vacancy for the remainder of the unexpired		
7	term by appointment of a state employee member or a nonstate employee member		
8	as the case may be. If a nonstate employee trustee leaves the employ of a		
9	participating public employer or a state employee trustee leaves or retires		
10	from state employment, the Governor shall declare a vacancy on the board.		
11	(B) The Governor shall appoint a state employee member or		
12	a nonstate employee member to fill the vacancy for the remainder of the		
13	unexpired term within thirty (30) days of the date on which the vacancy is		
14	declared.		
15			
16	SECTION 3. DO NOT CODIFY. This act applies to a member currently		
17	serving on the Board of Trustees of the Arkansas Public Employees' Retirement		
18	System as of the effective date of this act.		
19			
20	SECTION 4. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the General		
21	Assembly of the State of Arkansas that when a vacancy occurs in the Arkansas		
22	Public Employees' Retirement System, the Governor must be able to immediately		
23	appoint a trustee to fill the vacancy; that on the effective date of this		
24	act, the provisions of this act should apply to the current members of the		
25	board; and that this act shall become effective immediately in order to		
26	maintain the stability of the system and to avoid undue harm to the members		
27	and benefit recipients of the system. Therefore, an emergency is declared to		
28	exist, and this act being immediately necessary for the preservation of the		
29	public peace, health, and safety shall become effective on:		
30	(1) The date of its approval by the Governor;		
31	(2) If the bill is neither approved nor vetoed by the Governor,		
32	the expiration of the period of time during which the Governor may veto the		
33	bill; or		
34	(3) If the bill is vetoed by the Governor and the veto is		
35	overridden, the date the last house overrides the veto.
