23	BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

25	SECTION 1. Arkansas Code Title 20, Chapter 77, Subchapter 1, is
26	amended to add an additional section to read as follows:
27	<u>20-77-132. Walk-in clinic and emergent care clinic — Medicaid</u>
28	reimbursement.
29	(a) As used in this section:
30	(1) "Emergent care clinic" means a walk-in clinic focused on the
31	delivery of ambulatory care in a facility outside of traditional emergency
32	care; and
33	(2) "Walk-in clinic" means a medical clinic that accepts
34	patients on a walk-in basis and without an appointment.
35	(b) When a Medicaid beneficiary who does not have an assigned primary
36	<u>care provider utilizes or attempts to utilize a walk-in clinic or emergent</u>

1	care clinic, the walk-in clinic or emergency care clinic shall not decline to
2	treat the patient due to his or her lack of a primary care provider.
3	(c) The Arkansas Medicaid Program shall reimburse for up to four (4)
4	healthcare visits per year at a walk-in clinic or emergent care clinic when
5	the Medicaid beneficiary does not have a primary care provider assigned if
6	the walk-in clinic or emergent care clinic is associated with a hospital.
