For An Act To Be Entitled

8 *AN ACT TO ALLOW A SCHOOL BOARD MEMBER OR A SPOUSE OF*
9 *A SCHOOL BOARD MEMBER TO BE A VOLUNTEER OR A*
10 *REGISTERED VOLUNTEER UPON APPROVAL OF THE SCHOOL*
11 *BOARD AND THE COMMISSIONER OF EDUCATION; TO DECLARE*
12 *AN EMERGENCY; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.*

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16 *TO ALLOW A SCHOOL BOARD MEMBER OR A*
17 *SPOUSE OF A SCHOOL BOARD MEMBER TO BE A*
18 *VOLUNTEER OR A REGISTERED VOLUNTEER UPON*
19 *APPROVAL OF THE SCHOOL BOARD AND THE*
20 *COMMISSIONER OF EDUCATION; AND TO DECLARE*
21 *AN EMERGENCY.*

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24 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

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26 SECTION 1. Arkansas Code § 6-22-105(c), concerning requirements for
27 registered volunteers, is amended to read as follows:

28 (c)(1) A volunteer or registered volunteer may not be a member of the
29 board of directors of the school district or the spouse of a member of the
30 board of directors of the school district in which he or she seeks to
31 volunteer unless approved by the:

32 (A) Board of directors of the school district; and

33 (B) Commissioner of Education.

34 (2) The approval granted under subdivision (c)(1) of this
35 section shall be valid for a period of one (1) calendar year.

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1 SECTION 2. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the
 2 General Assembly of the State of Arkansas that there is a shortage of
 3 registered volunteers available for the public schools of this state; that
 4 under current, law members of the board of directors of a public school
 5 district and their spouses are prohibited from volunteering in the public
 6 school district in which the members of the board of directors serve; that
 7 members of the board of directors of a public school district and their
 8 spouses are members of the community of the public school district and have
 9 an interest in serving the public school district in every way possible; and
 10 that this act is immediately necessary so that public school districts can
 11 benefit from the valuable service members of the board of directors of a
 12 public school district and their spouses can bring as registered volunteers.
 13 Therefore, an emergency is declared to exist, and this act being immediately
 14 necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health, and safety shall
 15 become effective on:

16 (1) The date of its approval by the Governor;

17 (2) If the bill is neither approved nor vetoed by the Governor,
 18 the expiration of the period of time during which the Governor may veto the
 19 bill; or

20 (3) If the bill is vetoed by the Governor and the veto is
 21 overridden, the date the last house overrides the veto.
