 Fund Paying Account.

(a) The Division of Administrative Services Director's Office of the
Department of Human Services is hereby authorized to shall establish and
maintain as a cash fund account the Client Specific Emergency Services
Revolving Fund Paying Account consisting of federal grants, aids, cash
donations, reimbursements, and state general revenue, not to exceed a daily
balance of ten thousand dollars (\$10,000), for delivery of immediate care,
short-term, or emergency services to eligible clients.

(b) The account shall be established and maintained in accordance with procedures established by the Chief Fiscal Officer of the State for cash funds and shall be administered under the direction of the Director of the Department of Human Services.

Arkansas Code § 25-10-144(b), concerning the purpose of the 35 Governor's Advisory Commission on National Service and Volunteerism, is 36 amended to read as follows:

(b) The purposes of the Governor's Advisory Commission on National Service and Volunteerism are to: (1) Assist the community engagement program and staff of the Division of Community Service and Nonprofit Support the Director's Office of the Department of Human Services in setting goals, establishing priority activities, performing an advocacy role, and assisting in funding and resource development and publicity and recognition and awards programs; and (2) Serve as the State Commission on National and Community Service for the Edward M. Kennedy Serve America Act, as governed by 42 U.S.C. § 12638. SECTION 7. Arkansas Code § 25-10-144(g), concerning the Governor's Advisory Commission on National Service and Volunteerism, is repealed. (g) The Division of Community Service and Nonprofit Support may promulgate rules to implement this section.
