## For An Act To Be Entitled

AN ACT TO PROHIBIT INTERFERENCE WITH A TRAFFIC CONTROL DEVICE OR BARRICADE; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

## Subtitle

 TO PROHIBIT INTERFERENCE WITH A TRAFFIC CONTROL DEVICE OR BARRICADE.BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

SECTION 1. Arkansas Code Title 27, Chapter 51, Subchapter 1, is amended to add a new section to read as follows:

27-51-105. Interference with traffic control devices or barricades.
(a) As used in this section, "traffic control device" means a sign, signal, marking, or device placed or erected for the purpose of regulating, warning, or guiding traffic.
(b) If a traffic control device or barricade is placed or erected to close a public highway under the authority of the Arkansas State Highway and Transportation Department or local authorities on public highways, it is unlawful for a person to:
(1) Drive a vehicle through, under, over, or around the traffic control device or barricade; or
(2) Remove the traffic control device or barricade and enter the closed area.
(c) A violation of this section is punishable by a fine of not more than one thousand dollars $(\$ 1,000)$.
(d) A person convicted under this section shall:
(1) Pay restitution in an amount equal to the actual cost of the
emergency response and the replacement of any damaged or lost emergency equipment; and
(2) Be liable for damage to property, or injury or death to a person caused by the violation.
