(b) This application shall set forth at what time, not less than thirty (30) days nor more than ninety (90) days subsequent to the execution and filing thereof, the member desires to be retired. (c) Upon the member's retirement, he or she shall receive a pension provided for in § 24-6-406. SECTION 2. Arkansas Code § 24-6-502(1)(B), concerning elections to participate in the Arkansas State Police Officers' Tier Two Deferred Retirement Option Plan, is amended to read as follows: (B) Has at least thirty (30) twenty-eight (28) years of actual service as a member of the State Police Retirement System's Tier Two Benefit Plan under § 24-6-401 et seq.; and SECTION 3. Arkansas Code § 24-6-504(3), concerning monthly retirement benefits paid into the Arkansas State Police Officers' Tier Two Deferred Retirement Option Plan account, is amended to read as follows: (3) Seventy-two percent (72%) Eighty percent (80%) of the monthly retirement benefits that would have been payable had the employee elected to cease employment and receive a service retirement shall be paid into the Arkansas State Police Officers' Tier Two Deferred Retirement Option Plan account.
