SECTION 40. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. NON HAZARDOUS SITE CLEAN UP RESTRICTIONS. Expenditures from the Arkansas Department of Environmental Quality Fee Trust Fund for the cleanup of non hazardous sites which pose a threat to the environment, as appropriated in the Non Hazardous Site Cleanup appropriation section, shall be funded only through interest earnings from the Arkansas Department of Environmental Quality Fee Trust Fund. The Arkansas Department of Environmental Quality shall seek cost recovery from parties responsible for damages to the environment that dictate the use of appropriation authorized in the Non Hazardous Site Cleanup appropriation section of this act, as well as any other funds spent by a governmental entity to remediate such non hazardous sites.

The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1, 2016

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SECTION 41. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS

- 1 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. LANDFILL 2 POST-CLOSURE TRUST FUND.
 - (a) The General Assembly finds that:

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- 4 (1) A growing number of regional solid waste management districts 5 within the state are facing difficulty in funding the necessary costs of 6 closure and post-closure care of landfills owned by the districts; and
- 7 (2) Without closure and post-closure care of landfills, 8 irreparable harm to human health and the environment will occur.
- 9 (b) Notwithstanding Arkansas Code § 8-6-1001 et seq. and any Landfill 10 Post-Closure Trust Fund cleanup restrictions enumerated in this Act, the 11 Arkansas Department of Environmental Quality also may:
 - (1) Expend monies from the Landfill Post-Closure Trust Fund to a state-approved contractor or the regional solid waste management district to complete all actions necessary to achieve the final closure and post-closure care of a landfill owned by a regional solid waste management district if the department determines that the regional solid waste management district:
 - (A) Has filed for protection under federal bankruptcy law;
- 18 (B) Is unable to meet its debt obligations in the ordinary 19 course of its operations; or
 - (C) Is otherwise insolvent; and
 - (2) Institute a civil action against the regional solid waste management district and all of the entities composing the regional solid waste management district to seek the recovery of any funds expended from the Landfill Post-Closure Trust Fund under subdivision (b)(l) of this section, unless satisfactory repayment arrangements are reached and agreed upon by the department with the district and the bondholders.
- 27 (c) This section is in effect only from July 1, $\frac{2016}{2017}$ through June 30, $\frac{2017}{2018}$.

SECTION 42. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS

- 32 SUSPENSION OF LANDFILL DISPOSAL FEES TO SUPPORT A COMPUTER AND ELECTRONIC 33 EQUIPMENT RECYCLING PROGRAM.
- 34 (a) The landfill disposal fee to support a computer and electronic 35 equipment recycling program levied under Arkansas Code § 8-6-612(a) shall not 36 be levied from the effective date of this act through June 30, 2017 2018.

1	(b) Any landfill disposal fees collected under Arkansas Code § 8-6-
2	612(a) before the effective date of this act shall be:
3	(1) Collected as provided under Arkansas Code § 8-6-612(c); and
4	(2) Distributed as provided under Arkansas Code § 8-6-616 and

6	The provision of this section shall be in effect only from July 1, $\frac{2016}{1}$
7	<u>2017</u> through June 30, <u>2017</u> <u>2018</u> .

9	SECTION 43. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS
10	CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW.
11	INVESTMENTS. All funds that are held at any time in the Landfill Post-
12	Closure Trust Fund, Hazardous Substance Remedial Action Trust Fund, and
13	Petroleum Storage Tank Trust Fund may be invested and reinvested to the
14	extent feasible, and all investments as authorized for use by the Office of
15	the Treasurer may be available to the listed funds. The movement of these
16	funds into and out of investments shall be by fund transfers as directed by
17	the Director of the Arkansas Department of Environmental Quality.
18	The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1, 2017
19	through June 30, 2018.
20	
21	SECTION 44. COMPLIANCE WITH OTHER LAWS. Disbursement of funds
22	authorized by this act shall be limited to the appropriation for such agency
23	and funds made available by law for the support of such appropriations; and
24	the restrictions of the State Procurement Law, the General Accounting and
25	Budgetary Procedures Law, the Revenue Stabilization Law, the Regular Salary
26	Procedures and Restrictions Act, or their successors, and other fiscal
27	control laws of this State, where applicable, and regulations promulgated by
28	the Department of Finance and Administration, as authorized by law, shall be
29	strictly complied with in disbursement of said funds.

31	SECTION 45. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General
32	Assembly that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations
33	contained in this act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for
34	which this act was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive
35	Recommendations and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget
36	manuals prepared by the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or

1	summarized oral testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative
2	Council or Joint Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption.
3	
4	SECTION 46. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the
5	General Assembly, that the Constitution of the State of Arkansas prohibits
6	the appropriation of funds for more than a one (1) year period; that the
7	effectiveness of this Act on July 1, 2017 is essential to the operation of
8	the agency for which the appropriations in this Act are provided, and that in
9	the event of an extension of the legislative session, the delay in the
10	effective date of this Act beyond July 1, 2017 could work irreparable harm
11	upon the proper administration and provision of essential governmental
12	programs. Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act
13	being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health
14	and safety shall be in full force and effect from and after July 1, 2017.
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
