- 3 Waste Cleanup appropriation section, shall be funded only through interest
- 4 earnings and investment earnings from the Hazardous Substance Remedial Action
- 5 Trust Fund and additional funding from the Hazardous Substance Remedial
- 6 Action Trust Fund on July 1, 2017. Further, the Department shall report
- 7 biennially annually to the Arkansas Legislative Council or Joint Budget
- 8 Committee all expenditures from interest earnings for these purchases.
- 9 The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1, $\frac{2016}{1}$

- 12 SECTION 37. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS

- 14 APPROPRIATIONS RESTRICTIONS. No expenditure from the Environmental Settlement
- 15 Trust Fund for information technology needs may be made without prior
- 16 approval of the Chief Fiscal Officer of the State, after seeking review of
- 17 the Arkansas Legislative Council or Joint Budget Committee. Further,
- 18 utilization of this appropriation for information technology needs of the
- 19 Arkansas Department of Environmental Quality must also be approved by the
- 20 Executive Chief Information Officer after the project is evaluated on the
- 21 methodology recommended by the Chief Information Officer and the CIO Council,
- 22 including an analysis of the return on investment and linkage to the

- 30 SECTION 38. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS
- 31 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. FUND
- 32 TRANSFER PROVISION. Upon approval of the Chief Fiscal Officer of the State,
- 33 the Arkansas Department of Environmental Quality may transfer from various
- 34 department funds to the Arkansas Department of Environmental Quality Fund
- 35 Account the sum of \$1,500,000 in fiscal year $\frac{2016-2017}{2017-2018}$ for the
- 36 exclusive purpose of supplementing funding for the appropriation provided in

- 1 the State Operations appropriation section. The funds shall be used for

- 22 POST-CLOSURE CLEAN UP RESTRICTIONS. Any expenditures in excess of \$50,000

- 25 appropriation section, for corrective action to remedy environmental impacts

- 36 HAZARDOUS SITE CLEAN UP RESTRICTIONS. Expenditures from the Arkansas

- 1 Department of Environmental Quality Fee Trust Fund for the cleanup of non
- 2 hazardous sites which pose a threat to the environment, as appropriated in
- 3 the Non Hazardous Site Cleanup appropriation section, shall be funded only

- 18 (1) A growing number of regional solid waste management districts
- 19 within the state are facing difficulty in funding the necessary costs of
- 20 closure and post-closure care of landfills owned by the districts; and
- 21 (2) Without closure and post-closure care of landfills,
- 22 irreparable harm to human health and the environment will occur.
- 23 (b) Notwithstanding Arkansas Code § 8-6-1001 et seq. and any Landfill

- 12 (a) The landfill disposal fee to support a computer and electronic
- 13 equipment recycling program levied under Arkansas Code § 8-6-612(a) shall not
- 14 be levied from the effective date of this act through June 30, 2017 2018.
- 15 (b) Any landfill disposal fees collected under Arkansas Code § 8-6-
- 16 612(a) before the effective date of this act shall be:
- 17 (1) Collected as provided under Arkansas Code § 8-6-612(c); and
- 18 (2) Distributed as provided under Arkansas Code § 8-6-616 and
- 19 this Act.
- The provision of this section shall be in effect only from July 1, 2016
- 21 2017 through June 30, 2017 2018.

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- 23 SECTION 44. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS
- 24 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW.
- 25 <u>INVESTMENTS</u>. All funds that are held at any time in the Landfill Post-
- 26 Closure Trust Fund, Hazardous Substance Remedial Action Trust Fund, and
- 27 Petroleum Storage Tank Trust Fund may be invested and reinvested. subject to
- 28 the written approval of the Office of the Treasurer, to the extent feasible,
- 29 and all investments as authorized for use by the Office of the Treasurer may
- 30 be available to the listed funds. The movement of these funds into and out
- 31 of investments shall be by fund transfers as directed by the Director of the

10	SECTION 46. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General
11	Assembly that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations
12	contained in this act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for
13	which this act was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive
14	Recommendations and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget
15	manuals prepared by the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or
16	summarized oral testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative
17	Council or Joint Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption.
18	
19	SECTION 47. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the
20	General Assembly, that the Constitution of the State of Arkansas prohibits
21	the appropriation of funds for more than a one (1) year period; that the
22	effectiveness of this Act on July 1, 2017 is essential to the operation of
23	the agency for which the appropriations in this Act are provided, and that in
24	the event of an extension of the legislative session, the delay in the
25	effective date of this Act beyond July 1, 2017 could work irreparable harm
26	upon the proper administration and provision of essential governmental
27	programs. Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act
28	being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health
29	and safety shall be in full force and effect from and after July 1, 2017.
