- SECTION 2. Arkansas Code § 7-6-207(a)(2) and (3), concerning reports of contributions filed with the Secretary of State and resulting from Initiated Act 1 of 1990 and Initiated Act 1 of 1996, are amended to read as follows:
- (2) Upon receiving the first report from any candidate, or upon receipt of the candidate's notice of filing for office, the Secretary of State shall provide the candidate with information on the deadlines for filing remaining quarterly, monthly, and preelection reports and shall furnish each candidate with the appropriate forms and instructions for complying with the deadlines. All reports shall be filed on the forms furnished by the Secretary of State, except that computer-generated contribution and expenditure reports shall be accepted by the Secretary of State and the Arkansas Ethics Commission provided that all of the requisite elements are included.
  - (3) For any report except a preelection report, a A report is timely filed if it is either hand delivered or mailed to the Secretary of State, properly addressed, postage prepaid, bearing a postmark indicating that it was received by the post office or common carrier filed in electronic form through the official website of the Secretary of State on or before the date that the report is due. A preelection report is timely filed if it is received in the Secretary of State's office no later than seven (7) days prior to the election for which it is filed. The Secretary of State shall accept via facsimile any report, provided the original is received by the Secretary of State within ten (10) days of the date of transmission. The Secretary of State may receive reports in a readable electronic format that is acceptable to the Secretary of State and approved by the commission.

- SECTION 3. Arkansas Code § 7-6-207(d)(1), concerning reports of contributions filed with the Secretary of State and resulting from Initiated Act 1 of 1990 and Initiated Act 1 of 1996, is amended to read as follows:
  - (d) Filings and Public Inspection.
- 35 (1)(A)(i) The Secretary of State shall establish a filing system 36 for reports filed  $\frac{\text{pursuant to under}}{\text{pursuant to under}}$  this section.

I	(ii) The reports shall be kept for eight (8) years		
2	from the date of filing, catalogued by candidate in chronological order, and		
3	made available for public inspection.		
4	(iii) For eight (8) years after the reports are		
5	filed under this section, the Secretary of State is the official custodian of		
6	those records.		
7	(B)(i) After the eight-year period, the Secretary of State		
8	shall turn the reports over to the Arkansas State Archives for maintenance		
9	and continued public inspection.		
10	(ii) After the eight-year period, the Arkansas State		
11	Archives is the official custodian of the records of the reports filed under		
12	this section.		
13	(C)(i) The campaign contribution and expenditure reports		
14	filed with the Secretary of State under this section shall be filed in		
15	electronic form through the official website of the Secretary of State.		
16	(ii) The Arkansas Ethics Commission shall approve		
17	the format used by the Secretary of State for the filing of campaign		
18	contribution and expenditure reports in electronic form under subdivision		
19	(d)(l)(C)(i) of this section to ensure that all required information is		
20	requested.		
21	(iii) The official website of the Secretary of State		
22	shall allow for searches of campaign contribution and expenditure report		
23	information filed in electronic form under subdivision (d)(1)(C)(i) of this

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26	SECTION 4. Arkansas Code § 7-6-214(b), concerning the publication of		
27	campaign finance reports, is amended to read as follows:		
28	(b)(1) The Secretary of State shall post reports of contributions		
29	required in §§ 7-6-203 and 7-6-207 on his or her official website.		
30	(2) The official website of the Secretary of State shall allow		
31	for searches of campaign contribution and expenditure report information		
32	required to be filed in electronic form under § 7-6-207(d)(1)(C)(i).		
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34	SECTION 5. Arkansas Code Title 7, Chapter 6, Subchapter 2, is amended		
35	to add an additional section to read as follows:		
36	7-6-230. Alternative to electronic filing of reports.		

1	(a)(1) A candidate required to file carryover fund reports in		
2	electronic form under § 7-6-203 and campaign contribution and expenditure		
3	reports in electronic form under § 7-6-207 may file reports in paper form		
4	under this section if:		
5	(A) The candidate does not have access to the technology		
6	necessary to submit reports in electronic form; and		
7	(B) Submitting reports in electronic form would constitute		
8	a substantial hardship for the candidate.		
9	(2)(A) A candidate filing reports in paper form under		
10	subdivision (a)(1) of this section shall submit with his or her first paper		
11	report in an election cycle a notarized affidavit on a form prepared by the		
12	Secretary of State declaring that:		
13	(i) The candidate does not have access to the		
14	technology necessary to submit reports in electronic form;		
15	(ii) Submitting reports in electronic form would		
16	constitute a substantial hardship for the candidate; and		
17	(iii) The candidate agrees to file all other reports		
18	in paper form for the duration of the election cycle.		
19	(B) The Secretary of State shall not accept a report in		
20	paper form under subdivision (a)(l) of this section if a notarized affidavit		
21	was not submitted with the first paper report in the election cycle.		
22	(b)(l) The Secretary of State shall make available to candidates		
23	wishing to file reports in paper form under this section:		
24	(A) Information on the deadlines for filing required		
25	reports; and		
26	(B)(i) Appropriate forms and instructions for complying		
27	with the deadlines.		
28	(ii) The Arkansas Ethics Commission shall approve		
29	the forms and instructions used by the Secretary of State to ensure that all		
30	required information is requested.		
31	(2) Reports shall be filed on the forms furnished by the		
32	Secretary of State, except that computer-generated contribution and		
33	expenditure reports shall be accepted by the Secretary of State and the		
34	Arkansas Ethics Commission provided that all of the requisite elements are		
35	<pre>included.</pre>		
36	(c)(l)(A) A report submitted in paper form under this section other		

1	than a preelection report is timely filed if it is either hand delivered or
2	mailed to the Secretary of State, properly addressed, and postage prepaid,
3	bearing a postmark indicating that it was received by the post office or
4	common carrier on the date that the report is due.
5	(B) A preelection report submitted in paper form under
6	this section is timely filed if it is received by the Secretary of State no
7	later than seven (7) days before the election for which it is filed.
8	(2) The Secretary of State shall accept a report via facsimile,
9	provided the original is received by the Secretary of State within ten (10)
10	days of the date of facsimile transmission.
11	(d) The Secretary of State shall make available campaign contribution
12	and expenditure reports submitted in paper form, carryover fund reports
13	submitted in paper form, and affidavits accompanying reports filed in paper
14	form, on a portion of the official website of the Secretary of State.
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16	SECTION 6. EFFECTIVE DATE. Sections $1-5$ of this act shall become
17	effective October 1, 2017.
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19	SECTION 7. TEMPORARY LANGUAGE - DO NOT CODIFY. (a) The Secretary of
20	State shall provide that the website utilized for the submission of campaign
21	contribution and expenditure reports and carryover fund reports in electronic
22	form allows candidates to electronically upload campaign contribution and
23	expenditure information in lieu of manual entry of each contribution and
24	<pre>expenditure.</pre>
25	(b) The Secretary of State shall obtain the approval of the Arkansas
26	Ethics Commission before implementing the feature required by subsection (a)
27	of this section to ensure that all required information is requested through
28	the website.
29	(c) This section expires on June 30, 2018.
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
