8	(2) Be presented in large print;		
9	(3) Be placed at eye level to the student for easy viewing;		
10	(4) Display the Child Abuse Hotline number in bold print;		
11	(5) Contain instructions to call 911 for emergencies; and		
12	(6) Contain directions for accessing the website of the Division		
13	of Children and Family Services of the Department of Human Resources for more		
14	information on reporting abuse, neglect, and exploitation.		
15	(d)(1) The Department of Education shall administer the requirements		
16	under this section.
