3	SECTION 3. Arkansas Code § 7-5-703(c), concerning tie votes for United	
4	States Congress, is amended to read as follows:	
5	(c) $(1)$ Should any two (2) or more persons have an equal number of	
6	votes, and a higher number than any other person, the names of the two (2)	
7	candidates receiving the highest number of votes for United States Senator or	
8	<u>United States</u> Representative shall be certified to a special runoff election	
9	which shall be held $\frac{\text{three (3)}}{\text{four (4)}}$ weeks from the day on which the	
10	general election is held.	
11	(2) The special runoff election shall be conducted in the same	
12	manner as is $\frac{1}{100}$ provided by law, and the election results shall be canvassed	
13	and certified in the manner provided by law.	
14		
15	SECTION 4. Arkansas Code § 7-5-704(b), concerning tie votes for	
16	legislative, judicial, and executive officers, is amended to read as follows:	
17	(b) $\underline{(1)}$ If two (2) or more persons have an equal number of votes for	
18	the same office and a higher number than any other person, the names of the	
19	two (2) candidates receiving the highest number of votes for any legislative	
20	or executive office, except those offices named in Arkansas Constitution,	
21	Article 6, § 3, and constables, shall be certified to a special runoff	
22	election which shall be held $\frac{\text{three (3)}}{\text{four (4)}}$ weeks from the day on which	
23	the general election is held.	
24	(2) The special runoff election shall be conducted in the same	
25	manner as is now provided by law, and the election results thereof shall be	
26	canvassed and certified in the manner provided by law.

28	SECTION 5. Arkansas Code § 7-9-113(c), concerning publication of	
29	notice, is amended to read as follows:	
30	(c) At least one (l) notice shall:	
31	(1) contain Contain the number, the popular name, and the ballot

33	(2) Contain a complete text of the measure to be submitted;

3	SECTION 6. Arkansas Code § 7-9-126(b)(3)(A), concerning the count of		
4	signatures, is amended to read as follows:		
5	(3)(A) The canvasser is a paid canvasser whose name and the		
6	information required under § 7-9-601 were not submitted by the sponsor to the		
7	Secretary of State <del>before the petitioner signed the petition</del> upon filing the		
8	petition.		
9			
10	SECTION 7. Arkansas Code § 7-9-305(b)(2), concerning election and		
11	certification of delegates, is amended to read as follows:		
12	(2) $\underline{(A)}$ In the event that more than two (2) candidates are		
13	seeking a particular delegate position and that no candidate receives a		
14	majority of the votes cast for all candidates for the position, the names of		
15	the two (2) candidates receiving the highest number of votes for the position		
16	shall be certified to a special runoff election that shall be held by the		
17	respective county board of election commissioners of the district three (3)		
18	four (4) weeks from the day on which the general election is held.		
19	(B) The special runoff election shall be conducted in the		
20	same manner as is <del>now</del> provided by law, and the election results shall be		
21	canvassed and certified in the manner provided by law.		
22			
23	SECTION 8. Arkansas Code § 7-9-601(a) and (b), concerning the hiring		
24	and training of paid canvassers, is amended to read as follows:		
25	(a)(1) A person shall not provide money or anything of value to		
26	another person for obtaining signatures on a statewide initiative or		
27	referendum petition unless the person receiving the money or item of value		
28	meets the requirements of this section.		
29	(2) Before a signature is solicited by a paid canvasser the		
30	sponsor shall:		
31	(A) Provide the paid canvasser with a copy of the most		
32	recent edition of the Secretary of State's initiatives and referenda		
33	handbook; and		
34	(B) Explain the Arkansas law applicable to obtaining		
35	signatures on an initiative or referendum petition to the canvasser; and		
36	(C)(i) Provide a complete list of all paid canvassers'		

1	names and current residential addresses to the Secretary of State.	
2	(ii) If additional paid canvassers agree to solicit	
3	signatures on behalf of a sponsor after the complete list is provided, the	
4	sponsor shall provide an updated list of all paid canvassers' names and	
5	current residential addresses to the Secretary of State.	
6	(3) Upon filing the petition with the Secretary of State, the	
7	sponsor shall submit to the Secretary of State a:	
8	(A) List of the names and current residential addresses of	
9	each paid canvasser; and	
10	(B) Signature card for each paid canvasser.	
11	(b)(1) To verify that there are no criminal offenses on record, a	
12	sponsor shall obtain, at its cost, from the Department of Arkansas State	
13	Police, a current state and federal criminal record search on every paid	
14	canvasser to be registered with the Secretary of State.	
15	(2) The criminal record search shall be obtained within thirty	
16	(30) days $\frac{1}{\text{prior to}}$ before the $\frac{1}{\text{registration of}}$ date that the paid canvasser	
17	begins collecting signatures.	
18	(3) Upon submission of its list of paid canvassers to the	
19	Secretary of State, the sponsor shall certify to the Secretary of State that	
20	each paid canvasser in its employ has passed a criminal background search	
21	<u>check</u> in accordance with this section.	
22	(4) A willful violation of this section by a sponsor or paid	
23	canvasser constitutes a Class A misdemeanor.	
24	(5) Signatures incorrectly obtained or submitted under this	
25	section shall not be counted by the Secretary of State.	
26		
27	SECTION 9. Arkansas Code § 14-43-304(c)(1), concerning mayors in	
28	cities having mayor-council government, is amended to read as follows:	
29	(c)(l) In the event that $\underline{If}$ no candidate for mayor of a city of the	
30	first class receives a majority of the votes cast in the general election,	
31	the two (2) candidates receiving the highest number of votes shall be	
32	certified to a special runoff election $\frac{1}{2}$ that $\frac{1}{2}$ shall be held $\frac{1}{2}$	
33	four (4) weeks from the day on which the general election is held.	
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
