Arkansas Code § 7-9-126(b)(3)(A), concerning the count of 3 signatures, is amended to read as follows: 4 (3)(A) The canvasser is a paid canvasser whose name and the 5 information required under § 7-9-601 were not submitted by the sponsor to the 6 Secretary of State before the petitioner signed the petition upon filing the 7 petition. 8 9 SECTION 7. Arkansas Code § 7-9-305(b)(2), concerning election and 10 certification of delegates, is amended to read as follows: 11 (2)(A) In the event that more than two (2) candidates are 12 seeking a particular delegate position and that no candidate receives a 13 majority of the votes cast for all candidates for the position, the names of 14 the two (2) candidates receiving the highest number of votes for the position 15 shall be certified to a special runoff election that shall be held by the 16 respective county board of election commissioners of the district three (3) 17 four (4) weeks from the day on which the general election is held. 18 (B) The special runoff election shall be conducted in the 19 same manner as is now provided by law, and the election results shall be 20 canvassed and certified in the manner provided by law. 21 22 SECTION 8.
