11	at least one (1) from each congressional district:

13	SECTION 3. The introductory language of Arkansas Code § 7-4-101(f) and

EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the 18 General Assembly of the State of Arkansas that the State Board of Election 19 Commissioners is a substantial component of the election process; that 20 effective elections are essential to the preservation of a citizen's right to 21 vote; and that this act is necessary to complete the transfer of the State 22 Board of Election Commissioners before the 2017 annual school election. 23 Therefore, an emergency is declared to exist, and this act being necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health, and safety shall become 24 25 effective on July 1, 2017. 26 27 28 29 30 31 32 33 34 35 36

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
