3	of Governor may issue, in addition to any deputy authorized pursuant to law		
4	to exercise all of the powers and discharge the duties of the office, shall		
5	designate by title emergency interim successors, and specify their order of		
6	succession.		
7	(2) The officer shall review and revise, as necessary,		
8	designations made pursuant to this subchapter to ensure their current status.		
9	(3) The officer will designate a sufficient number of emergency		
10	interim successors so that there will be not less than three (3) nor more		
11	than seven (7) deputies or emergency interim successors or any combination		
12	thereof, at any time.		
13	(b)(1) In the event that any state officer is unavailable following an		
14	attack and in the event his or her deputy, if any, is also unavailable, the		
15	powers of his or her office shall be exercised, and the duties of his or her		
16	office shall be discharged, by his or her designated emergency interim		
17	successors in the order specified.		
18	(2) The emergency interim successors shall exercise the powers		
19	and discharge the duties only until:		
20	(A) Where a vacancy exists, the Governor or other official		
21	authorized under the Arkansas Constitution or this subchapter to exercise the		
22	powers and discharge the duties of the Office of Governor appoints a		
23	successor to fill the vacancy or a successor is otherwise appointed, or		
24	elected and qualified as provided by law; or		
25	(B) An officer or his or her deputy or a preceding named		
26	emergency interim successor becomes available to exercise or resume the		
27	exercise of the powers and discharge the duties of his or her office.		
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
